Background

At Salisbury District Hospital (SDH), Salisbury NHS Foundation Trust provides a range of clinical care, which includes general acute and emergency services, to approximately 225,000 people in Wiltshire, Dorset and Hampshire. Specialist services, such as burns, plastic surgery, cleft lip and palate, genetics and rehabilitation, extend to a much wider population of more than three million people. Trust staff provide outpatient clinics in other locations in Dorset and Hampshire. Specialist staff hold outreach clinics in hospitals within the Wessex area and, in total, the Trust employed 3,890 staff at 30 September 2014. This includes full and part-time staff.

This Procurement

The Trust is planning substantial changes to the way patients flow through the Hospital, with the aim of creating a better environment in which to deliver outstanding patient experience.

As part of this, we are inviting tenders from suitably qualified and experienced bidders to undertake remodelling and refurbishment works within the Acute Medical Unit (AMU).

Interested bidders may access the relevant documents and tender drawings via the Trust's Bravo procurement portal. PLEASE NOTE bidders or their subcontractors MUST NOT contact Trust staff directly.

Completed tender responses, via the Bravo portal only, must be received by the close date of Wednesday 5th July, at 12:00.

The bid spreadsheet automatically calculates appropriate fields. DO NOT change these calculations, or make amendments to any cells other than your pricing response. Return this file as an Excel workbook, do not convert to pdf.

The project asks you to quote for TWO options :

1. The COMPLETE scheme, as detailed in issued drawings and the pricing / specification workbook,
2. A PARTIAL scheme, defined by the yellow shaded area on the issued plan.

Bidders are responsible for ensuring that for the partial scheme, they have still quoted any work outside the yellow area which is still required for delivery of the partial scheme.
