Scope of works

The principle objective of this project is to undertake a full drainage survey of all drainage assets, conducted to CS 551 & CD 535 Drainage survey and asset data and risk management standards.

Full drainage survey on the M4 eastbound motorway nearside verge and M4 eastbound on-slip between MP132.2 and MP132.8 to confirm existence and condition of all drainage assets.

Traffic Management: Lane closures & on-slip closure as required for safe working.
