This contract is to create fish passage by installing 15 timber baulks - 300mm x 300mm with notches in – 600mm wide by 200mm deep with fixings either side to the original brickwork using stainless steel fixings as specified on the drawings. A site compound can be negotiated with the landowner off Clough Road. This site is SD 87613 06821 and postcode is M24 2LJ. There will be over pumping required to enable in-channel works for installation of the timbers.
