### **Equipment Bag List**

- Blue canvas bag (Velcro closing) Animals on the Network.
- Red canvas bag, (Velcro closing) Load cell, tow strap & Round Sling with Shackle
- Blue canvas bag, (Velcro closing) Brother Straps, shackles & round slings. Small pouch 2x ABS's
- Yellow canvas bag (Velcro closing) Skates & lump hammer.
- Red canvas bag (Velcro closing) ETM Lighting equipment
- Fluorescent green, zip closing Waterproof ponchos and thermal blankets.
- Dark blue holdall zip closing [Redacted under FOIA Section 43(2) Commercial Interests], cable ties, dust masks, safety cutter.




#### 1. Left hand side





- 1. 2 stacks of 5 Cones
- 2. Crowbar & Threading Tool (stowed handle first to prevent snagging)
- Dark Blue holdall containing
   bags of absorbent material
   Cable ties, dust masks, safety cutter (tucked into the window recess)







### **Absorbent Material – Dark blue holdall**




- 3 bags of absorbent material



## 4. Cage – shelf 1



- Blue roll mat
- Box of nitrile gloves
- Black bags
- First Aid Box (behind the equipment bag)
- Fluorescent Green Canvas
   Bag Emergency safety
   products, Ponchos; Blankets;
   & Tape



# Waterproof ponchos and thermal blankets - Fluorescent green, zip closing

- Contents of bag
  - Rain ponchos
  - Adult thermal blankets
  - Incident tape x2









### 4. Cage – shelf 2







#### In order (first in last out)

- Yellow canvas bag (Velcro closing) -Skates & lump hammer – placed horizontally.
- 2. <u>Blue canvas bag</u> (Velcro closing) Brother Straps, shackles & round slings. 2 x ABS's <u>placed</u> horizontally.
- 3. Red canvas bag (Velcro closing) Load cell, tow strap & Round Sling with Shackle placed length ways.
- 4. Redacted under FOIA Section 43(2) Commercial Interests.



### Skates & Lump Hammer – yellow canvas bag, Velcro closing





- Contents of bag
  - Vehicle skates x4
  - Lump hammer



# Brother straps, shackles and round sling – blue canvas bag, Velcro closing



- Contents of bag
  - Brother straps
  - Shackles x2
  - Round Sling
  - ABS strap x2 (contained in small bag, please note that the small bag is part of an on-going project to be rolled)

  - Loadcell including tow strap
  - Round sling & shackle



### Cage – shelf 3



- Deployable Signs
- 1. F2 DIVERT Sign (610 arrow)
  - Right Divert Arrow
- 2. F2 INCIDENT SLOW Sign
  - 2 x Incident Slow Sign
  - 1 x No Entry Sign
- 3. F2 DIVERT Sign (610 arrow)
  - Left Divert Arrow
- 4. Extender Feet for 610 Signs



## Right hand side




- Two-part plastic shovel & black handle
- 2. 2 stacks of 5 Cones
  - Dark Blue holdall containing 3 bags of absorbent material, cable ties and dust masks (tucked into the window recess)

Right hand side




- Behind the passenger back seat
  - Left hand side:
    - Rapid charging cable
    - Binoculars
  - Right hand side:
    - 15L Chemical Spill Kit
    - Blue canvas bag (Velcro closing) - Animals on the Network.



### Animals on the Network – blue canvas bag, Velcro closing

- Bottle of water
- Dog Chew
- Arm guards x2
- Swan rescue bag
- Swan vest
- Collapsible bowl
- Horse bridal
- Dog lead (contained within small red bag)
- repellent spray (Must not be left in the vehicle when not in use)







### Behind the passenger seat



- AED Defibrillator
- Ready Rescue Kit (defibrillator)
- Resuscitation Aid

Please note: the internal grill is smaller in the BMW and when testing the bracket and defib in this vehicle, it showed that when fitted, it impeded vision through the rear view mirror. With approval from Neil Tyson it was approved that in this vehicle only, the defib would be housed in the passenger seat pocket.



#### **Backseat footwell**



- Searchlight
- Box of paperwork
- Scene commander tabard

Please Note – There is an ongoing project to replace the hard document box with a soft document wallet. Once complete this wallet is to be stored in the seat back pocket.



#### **Centre Console of Vehicle**



- Emergency Hammer
  - Allows to break glass in an emergency
  - Recessed blade to cut through seatbelts, etc.



### **Seasonal Items**

- Sunscreen Mainly stored in the Outstation but during hot weather would usually be put into the glove box or center console.
- Bottle of water
- Can of de-icer spray

### Request Items

Large animal response kit

# Items for Incident Screens

- Tyre pressure gauge kept with the incident screens.
- Anemometer kept in the glove box
