



IS THAT A BOMB?

STOP. DON'T TOUCH!

If you uncover an object that has a similar size and shape to a WWII bomb or other ordnance item, stop what you are doing – and try to avoid disturbing the item further.



WHAT NEXT?

If you find a suspicious item that you are not sure about, contact a senior member of site staff, make them aware that there is a potential threat to site safety and contact Zetica. If you find an item that definitely looks like ordnance, contact a senior member of site staff and call the police.

Under both circumstances, the area should be made out of bounds until the situation is resolved.



WHAT TO LOOK FOR

After 60 or more years in the ground, bombs and other ordnance items generally maintain their shape, but will become very rusty and decayed.

Commonly found unexploded bombs range in size from 90cm (3ft) to 2.5m (8ft) while other smaller ordnance related items can be found from bullet size to a large shell with a diameter of over 100mm (4in.).
