#### **ELMHURST PARK**

#### Daily:

Daily inspections of the park

Watering as required

Visual daily inspection of Children's Play area

Litter bins to be emptied including any litter in surrounding areas

#### Weekly:

Lawn mowing of defined areas (year-round cutting)

Trimming round obstacles such as trees, benches etc.

Edge maintenance

Removal of mounds and filling in of holes that may cause damage

After a period of 6 weeks, herbage in bulb planted areas to be cut as part of normal routine

Weeding of beds, base of hedges and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Maintenance of plants (dead heading, pruning) little and often.

Irrigate immature trees as required

Wipe benches clean once a week in summer months

Sweep floors and collect debris (incl Bandstand)

Sweep pathways

Remove graffiti

Flying of flag on specified days

Weekly contact with Town Council Officers

#### Monthly:

Wash painted woodwork on public shelter

Wash Bandstand floor

Removal of any algae of moss on hard surfaces or pathways

Lawn re-seeding when required

Minor maintenance of play area to incl. greasing of swings etc.

Checking of stakes for immature trees to loosen as required

#### Annually:

Lawns to be scarified once a year and fed in spring/summer

Cut back foliage and spent flowers of herbaceous plants in the autumn

Roses to be pruned and trained

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Deputy / Town Clerk/ Chair of Amenities Committee Replacement planting to take place between October to April.

Hedge cutting twice per year June and August/September

Minor pruning of immature trees

Every other year, in the winter months – Clean and paint all litter bins

#### KINGSTON FIELD

#### Daily:

Daily inspections of the park

Watering as required

Visual daily inspection of Children's Play area

Litter bins to be emptied including any litter in surrounding areas

Ensure the stream is kept free of obstacles, remove and debris

#### Weekly:

Lawn mowing (using a Gang mower) of defined areas (year-round cutting)

Disposal of all cuttings at bins located in Elmhurst Park

Trimming round obstacles such as trees, benches etc.

Edge maintenance

Removal of mounds and filling in of holes that may cause damage

Weeding of base of hedges and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Irrigate immature trees as required

Wipe benches clean once a week in summer months

Sweep pathways

Remove graffiti

### Monthly:

Removal of any algae of moss on hard surfaces or pathways

Checking of stakes for immature trees to loosen as required

Re seeding lawn when required

Minor maintenance of play area to incl. greasing of swings etc.

#### Annually:

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Council Officers and Chair of Amenities Committee Hedge cutting twice per year June and August/September Minor pruning of immature trees

Every other year, in the winter months – Clean and paint all litter bins

#### **FEN MEADOW**

#### Daily:

Daily inspections of the park

Visual daily inspection of Children's Play area

Litter bins to be emptied including any litter in surrounding areas

#### Weekly:

Lawn mowing of defined areas (year-round cutting)

Trimming round obstacles such as trees, benches etc.

Edge maintenance

Removal of mounds and filling in of holes that may cause damage

Weeding of base of hedges and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Irrigate immature trees as required

Wipe benches clean once a week in summer months

Sweep pathways

Remove graffiti

#### Monthly:

Removal of any algae of moss on hard surfaces or pathways

Re seeding when required

Checking of stakes for immature trees to loosen as required

Minor maintenance of play area to incl. greasing of swings etc.

### Annually:

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Town Council Officers and Chair of Amenities Committee

Wild meadow area to be cut once in late September/October (Orchids)

Areas of nettles and brambles to be cut back in winter

Hedge cutting twice per year February and August/September

Minor pruning of immature trees

Every other year, in the winter months – Clean and paint all litter bins

#### **BROOMHEATH**

#### Weekly:

Prune back gorse obstructing paths

Keep free of litter and debris all year

Removal of graffiti

Inspect for fire damage

#### Monthly:

Minor repairs to carpark when necessary

Maintenance of fences planting areas

#### Annually:

Gorse to be pruned back each winter.

Trees to be inspected in Autumn and any branches over paths and branches that fall below head height, removed.

Re inspect trees in the summer, remove branches that fall below head height.

Cut back roadside vegetation in winter and on weekly visits.

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Town Council Officers and Chair of Amenities Committee

### WAR MEMORIAL GARDENS

### Weekly:

Weekly visit to attend to the plants and trees

Sweep the paved area

Keep free of litter and debris all year

Removal of graffiti

#### Monthly:

Weeding of beds and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Maintenance of plants (dead heading, pruning) little and often.

#### Annually:

Cut back foliage and spent flowers of herbaceous plants in the autumn

Roses to be pruned and trained

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Council Town Officers and Chair of Amenities Committee

Replacement planting to take place between October to April.

Hedge cutting twice per year June and August/September

Preparation of Remembrance day

Jet Washing bi-annually or when required

#### **QUAKER BURIAL GROUND**

#### Weekly:

Weekly visit to attend to the plants and trees

Keep free of litter and debris all year

Removal of graffiti

Grass to be cut as required

Keep pathways clear

### Monthly:

Weeding of beds and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Maintenance of plants (dead heading, pruning) little and often.

#### Annually:

Cut back foliage and spent flowers of herbaceous plants in the autumn

Roses to be pruned and trained

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Town Council Officers and Chair of Amenities Committee

Replacement planting to take place between October to April.

#### FITZGERALD GREEN

#### Weekly:

Inspections of the park

Lawn mowing of defined areas (year-round cutting)

Trimming round obstacles such as trees, benches etc.

Edge maintenance

Removal of mounds and filling in of holes that may cause damage

Weeding of base of hedges and pathways, slabbed areas, bases of trees

Irrigate immature trees as required

Wipe benches clean once a week in summer months

#### Remove graffiti

#### Monthly:

Re seeding when required

Checking of stakes for immature trees to loosen as required

#### Annually:

Early Autumn and late winter inspections with Deputy/Town Clerk/Chair of Amenities Committee

Hedge cutting twice per year June and August/September

Minor pruning of immature trees

#### MARKET HILL AND SHIRE HALL

#### Weekly:

Weekly visit to sweep Market Hill and front of Shire Hall.

Water the flowers and hanging baskets as required

Weeding of steps and Market Hill area.

Removal of graffiti

Clear paved areas of snow as required

#### THEATRE STREET AMENITY GRASS

### Monthly:

Lawn mowing of defined areas (year-round cutting)

Trimming round obstacles such as trees, benches etc.

Edge maintenance

Removal of mounds and filling in of holes that may cause damage

Removal of graffiti if required

#### WHISTOCKS PLACE

#### Weekly:

Swept and cleaned

Removal of weeds as required

Planters to be watered

Plants in planters to be maintained and replaced when required

### Weekly:

Planters to be watered






# Map of Elmhurst ParkLime Kiln Quay Road, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 1BB




# Map of Kingston FieldThe Avenue, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 4BA




# Map of Fen MeadowSeckford Street, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 4LZ




# 4 Map of BroomheathSeckford Street, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 4LZ



# Map of War Memorial GardensMarket Hill, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 4LP




# Map of Quaker Burial Ground, Turn LaneTurn Lane, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 4AR




# Map of Fitzgerald Green, Sun LaneSun Lane, Woodbridge, Suffolk, IP12 1EG
