

Further to your submission of a tender for the above procurement, I am writing to advise that the Procurement is now complete. On behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport, the Department proposes to <u>accept</u> your tender, which was submitted on 28/12/2023, and therefore we would like to award the contract to you.

Once awarded, the contract shall commence upon signature and shall terminate on 31/03/2025, with the option to extend for a period of up to 6 months. The maximum contract value will be £60,000.00 excl. VAT. However, the sum paid will be subject to DfT's demand for the service – and there is no commitment to use the full contract value.

As set out in the ITT, a standstill period will now occur before the contract can be formally awarded to allow any appeals against the proposed award decision to be lodged. The standstill period will commence on 23/01/2024 and finish on 05/02/2024.

The contract will be formally awarded following the standstill period. This is without prejudice to the right of the Secretary of State for Transport to abandon the procurement, cancel the award procedure or suspend awarding the contract for any reason.
