1 Executive Summary

Daisy would like to thank the Care Quality Commission "CQC" for the opportunity to provide a proposal for the supply of mobile voice and data services.

This proposal is valid for 90-days and subject to either a new 24 month Direct Award or a 12 month extension using the existing framework contract option. Both options can take effect from the expiry of the existing minimum contract term - 31/03/23.

- Co-terminus contract for all existing / supplementary new connections
- Support for 2,732 connections
- 10% disconnection allowance (273 connections) without penalty during contract

At high-level CQC currently have a mobile estate of **c.2,732 live mobile connections** on the Daisy (O2) network. All connections reside on our unlimited standard UK minute and SMS inclusive framework tariff plus share an account level data pool of **3.5TB per month**.

In a competitive marketplace we recognise the need to ensure the solution is compelling, therefore we have proposed **monthly airtime credits** to further strengthen the overall commercial tariff.

Daisy demonstrates a long history of providing similar solutions and back this up with **Service Levels** upon which CQC can rely. Any contract must be able to flex with CQC; the business may change which will require expansion or contraction. The provider must also be ready to challenge CQC thinking and bring innovation that will provide real benefit to employees and customers.

To support the solution Daisy will offer a **service desk** for all supplied products governed by formal performance indicators and published escalation channels where required. Our service desk will provide 1st and 2nd line support for the management of basic technical and service-related requests.

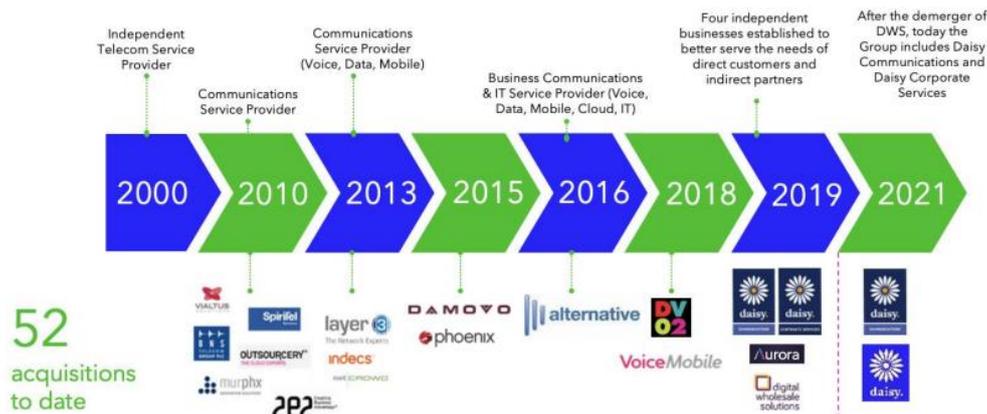
Further Daisy will provide **proactive and responsive account management** available daily and to drive quarterly review meetings to exceed operational requirements. Service desk and account management are further enhanced by a high availability secure online self-service management and billing portal. MyAccount has been developed to provide granular control, extensive reporting capabilities and key service management features.

2 About Daisy

Daisy History



Daisy was founded in 2001 by founder and Chairman Matthew Riley. In a telecoms marketplace that had historically been dominated by the nation's incumbent provider, Daisy was established to disrupt the monopolised business market. Targeting the often forgotten and under-resourced small business community, and bound to no single network or supplier, Daisy developed a service proposition that enabled the procurement of best-of-breed services that could be delivered on one bill. Having founded Daisy with a handful of staff, the company experienced rapid organic growth in its first five years and was named the fastest growing technology business in the UK in the 2005 Sunday Times' Tech Track.

In 2007, Matthew Riley was named the inaugural winner of the Bank of Scotland's Entrepreneur Challenge and the business was awarded £5m in interest-free funding, a treasure trove used to build the company further by acquisition.

In 2009, the business floated on the London Stock Exchange's Alternative Investment Market (AIM). Daisy acquired the businesses of, or certain assets from, Vialtus, ATC, Eurotel, Aerofone and Redstone.

In 2010-2012, Daisy expanded its data and telecoms service offerings with acquisitions including the businesses of, or certain assets from, BNS, Murphx, Spiritel, Outsourcery, Telinet and Worldwide.

In 2013-2014, Daisy began to develop its IT capabilities to sell into the existing customer base with acquisitions of Net Crowd, Indecs, Layer 3 and Daisy Data Centre.

In December 2014, Daisy once again became a private company in order to embark on its next stage of growth. Daisy acquired Damovo UK in early 2015 and Phoenix IT Group in the summer of that same year.

The end of 2016 saw the 50th Daisy acquisition of Alternative Networks further strengthen our mobile and fixed line product and service offerings.



In June 2018, Daisy expanded its SMB Direct customer base with the acquisition of DVO2 and its SMB Indirect customer base with the acquisition of Voice Mobile - a direct EE partner.

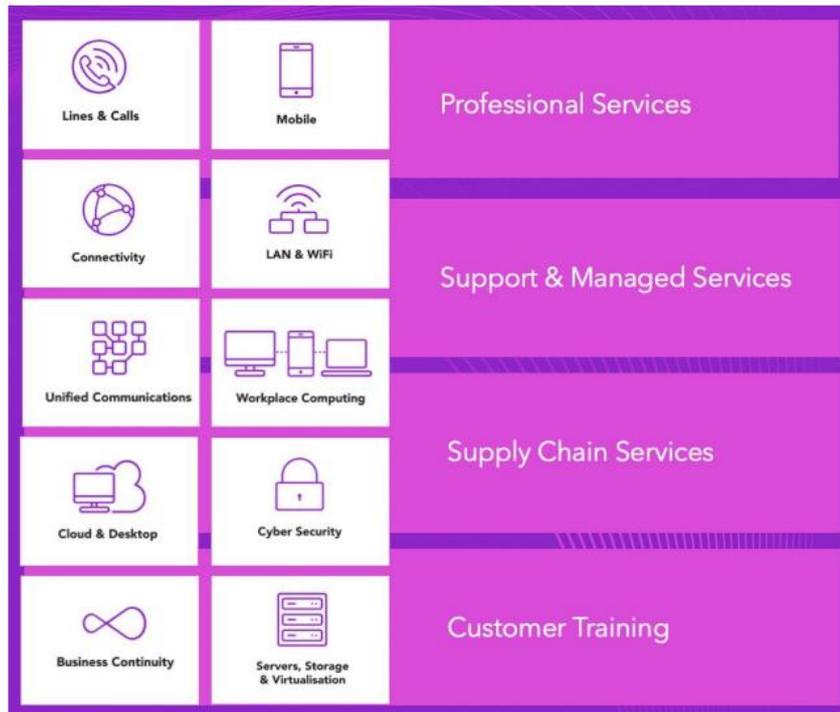

3 Commercial Proposal

Proposed Solution:

The Daisy mobile airtime tariff is underpinned by the O2 UK network and reinforces our belief that working with a best of breed partner backed by the exceptional in-house service management staff and platforms of Daisy delivers a compelling proposition.

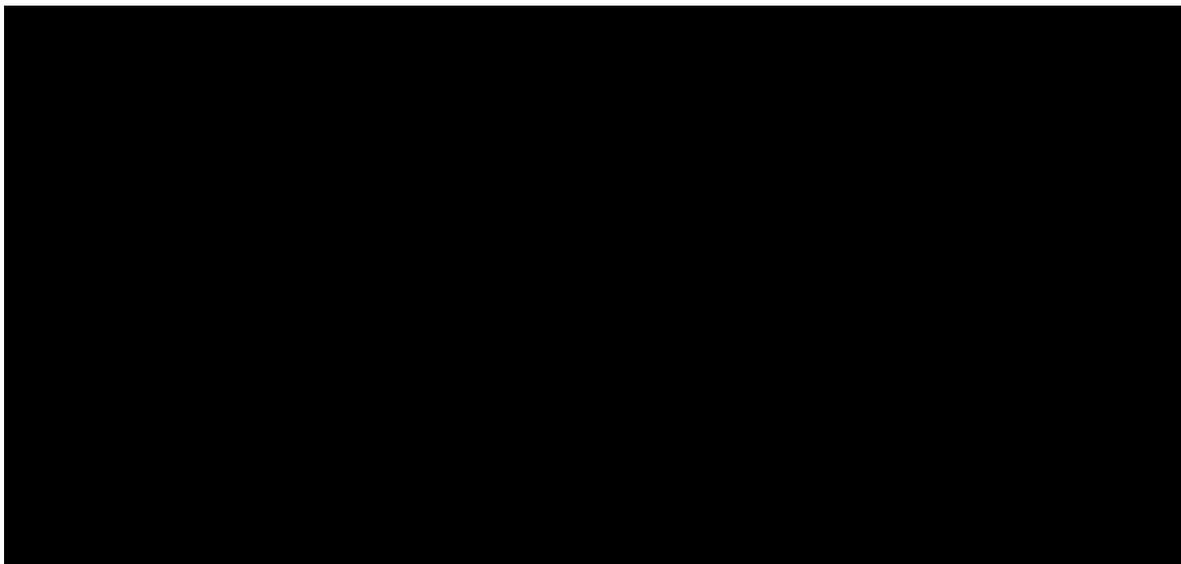
Daisy's exclusive Crown Commercial Services tariff will form the core of our. The tariff includes unlimited standard UK & EU voice minutes and SMS. At account level Daisy have recommended 2.5TB shared across all O2 connections on the account. We propose a reduction from the existing 3.5TB on the grounds the existing data usage is c.1.7TB per month (past six month average).

14/02 - Added in two options with 3TB as per request of CQC.

Where permitted all connections can have access to Daisy's European 'Roam like at Home' and 'World Travel Select' overseas roaming solutions (see below for details).

It is important to outline that individual usage alerts and/or limits can be set based on user profile, these can be setup at contract commencement and managed via our online platform. All end point connections will utilise the same core voice or data only tariff, this will limit the ongoing management of end user tariffs while minimising the risk of overuse and overspend.

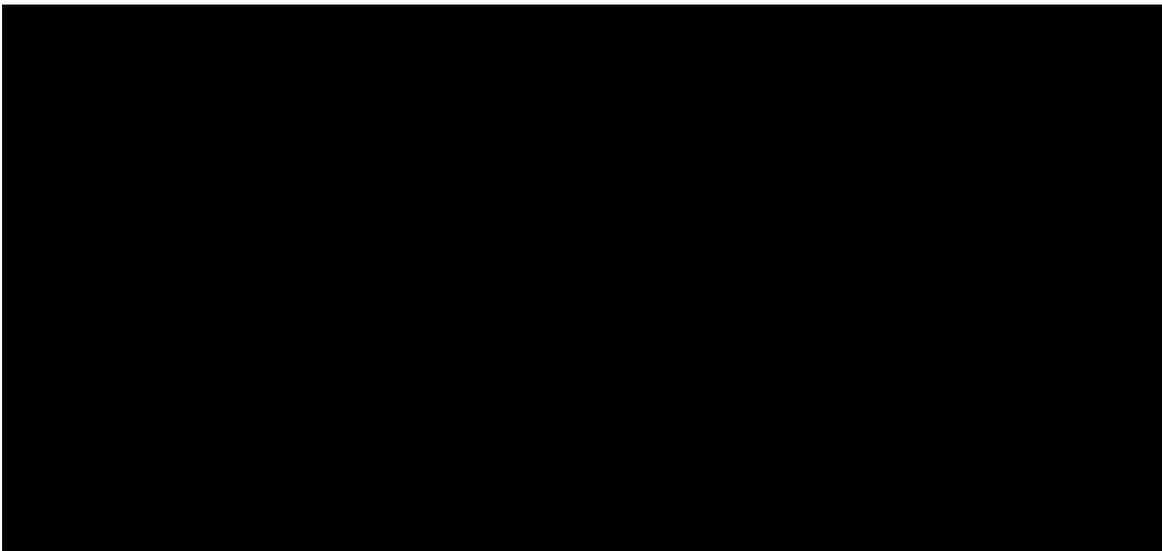




Option-2: 12 month Extension (available via existing contract)

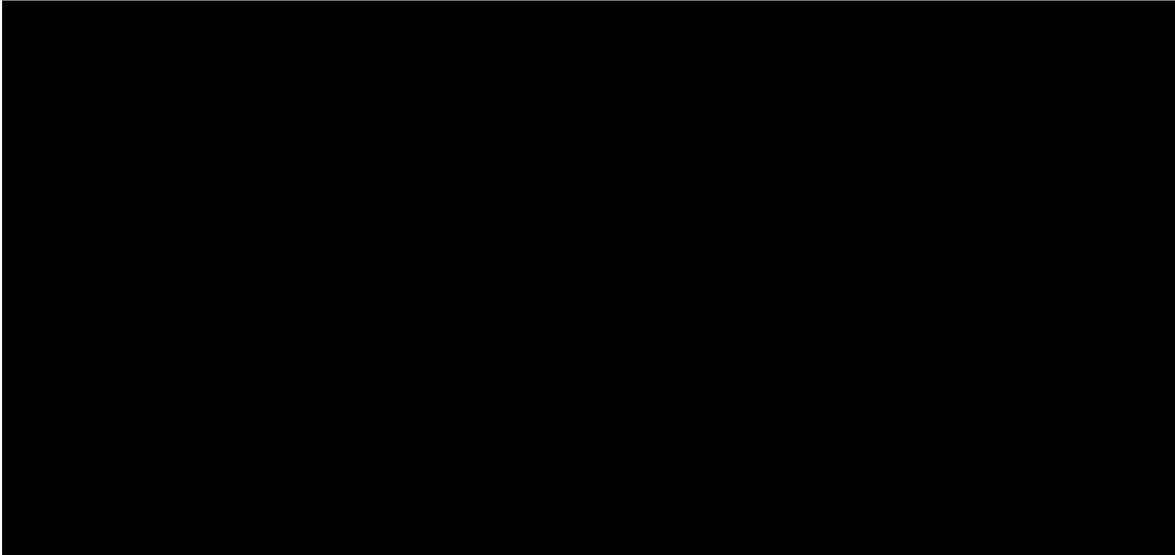


Option-3: 24 month (new) Direct Award

4 Account & Service Management

Relationship management is split into two functional areas and is roles based. The scope and complexity of your requirements will determine whether the roles will be provided by a single individual or by a team adopting individual responsibilities. In all cases there will be a single overall relationship owner. By adopting this approach with defined roles and responsibilities we ensure that the relationship management is cost effective and efficient.

Account management is responsible for the overall management of the relationship ranging from the strategic engagement and development with the customer and their business, to the day-to-day commercial interface. Account management deals with meetings, communications and escalations on commercial and relationship matters including liaising with contracts, finance, and legal matters.

Service management is responsible for the overall management of the service delivery as well as the development of the services ranging from strategic engagement with the customer and their business to the day-to-day service interface. Service management deals with performance management and reporting, continuous service improvement, customer service, governance, and service escalations.

Commercial tasks and activities

- Business development, making sure that you have access to appropriate experts and resources for the existing deliverables and service development. Ensuring that you are aware of the range of products and services that Daisy and the industry has to offer and the additional value that can be realised from their adoption and use.
- Contract renewal, where we work with you to benchmark the services to be fit for purpose and use while remaining competitive in the marketplace.
- Managing day to day commercial escalations, including contract changes, business engagement, account and billing queries, personnel management etc.
- Generate proposals to introduce new services or respond to your requests or capability assessments ensuring the content is accurate and reflective of the requirements.
- Managing and adjusting the contract to ensure it maintains synergy with your changing demands including legislative changes and movements in your business structure or scale. Ensuring that the associated billing and payments activities are aligned to the services provided.
- Relationship tasks and activities
- Setting expectations to advise you and our own internal departments of what to expect from the team in terms of engagement and outcomes.
- Pro-active communication to encourage active participation in productive meetings, organised with agendas and expected outcomes. To ensure that records and actions are taken appropriately and followed to a satisfactory conclusion.



- Relationship management to understand and communicate the roles, responsibilities and profiles of the customer and Daisy stakeholders in the account including producing and managing a RACI matrix where appropriate.

Service management tasks and activities

- Managing and reporting on performance across the service scope including, where appropriate, customer supply chain, third party providers, internal and external teams, and resolver groups.
- Developing SLAs and KPIs with you in response to your business requirements and in accordance with the contract to provide a baseline for service reporting and improvement.
- Managing the acceptance into service of new and transitioned services and technology changes to validate they are fit for purpose and use by ensuring completeness of plans, impact, and risks assessments etc. Ensuring that the correct processes, tools, and systems are implemented to measure and manage the services. Ensuring that supporting subcontracts and OLAs are in place to support the services.
- Plan for growth and change in the requirements by utilising the change process to propose, review and contribute to changes including advising on the service implications of proposed changes.
- Embed and maintain a continuous improvement programme to review and manage the development and evolution of the service through transformation and continuous service improvement activities. We will engage regularly with the organisation, service providers and industry using innovation workshops. We will design, propose, and implement service improvements as outputs from capacity planning, process management and the services to maintain quality and consistency.
- Establish and/or maintain a service governance structure to manage aspects of the services in line with industry standards and methodologies including ITIL, PRINCE2, ISO IEC standards 20000, and 27000.
- Producing, analysing, presenting, and developing the service reporting suite, including historic and predicted performance, progress against continuous service improvement initiatives, availability, capacity, and continuity reporting in addition to engaging with the project teams for progress stage reports.
- Drive customer satisfaction by engaging with you to establish meaningful satisfaction measures and initiatives to enhance the user experience of the services. Taking day-to-day responsibility for the quality of the service and liaising with you on service delivery issues. Be proactive in the dissemination of feedback from you through service review meetings and customer satisfaction surveys) into the Daisy delivery organisation.
- Be responsible for the service catalogue to ensure the services are defined and that changes are documented.
- Be responsible for ensuring that service levels and targets are met and implement effective, predefined escalation procedures.



5 Online Billing & Management

Daisy will provide CQC access to online portals whereby you can self-serve the products we provide under a single access. CQC will have access to MyAccount and CSM Portal. By logging onto CSM you will be able to access MyAccount from a central location.

MyAccount will provide billing and usage data and CSM will provide service functionality.

CQC will be given access to the online MyAccount billing platform for the duration of the contract.

MyAccount gives you full visibility of your Daisy services and allows you to self-manage your numbers 24/7. MyAccount provides a view of full billing itemisation to analyse, download and compare, create dynamic reports, set alerts and bars, manage cost centres, order SIM cards and handsets, log and track standard requests and more.

Access is via a web portal available through any browser with individual login with password and an email address validation procedure for security. No additional software download or plug in is required to enable access.

CQC will have access to the following features;

- My Bill
- My Reports
- My Alerts
- Self Service
- Support Centre

My Bill

CQC can view PDF bills via the MyAccount platform as well as downloading an entire itemised calls, services or cost centre reports. Daisy recommends that if you want a more detailed review of usage and costs, to extract the information into Excel for further analysis. This can be done for Mobile and Fixed services.

CQC can view both summary, and itemised versions of their Bill by clicking on the "View" options within the "My Bill" drop list. From here the user can break down the amount they have been charged for each product, and also charge type. i.e. 'One Off' or 'Recurring'

Features available in MyBill include;

- View and download PDF invoice
- View cost centre - user/cost centre analysis
- View and analyse calls - usage analysis
- View services - user tariff information

Your call data can be downloaded in the following formats; xls, xlsx and csv.



My Reports

Reporting in MyAccount allows you to create and view bespoke reports, these include:

- Call Reports
- Alert Reports
- Mobile Base Reports

Customisable reports and user definable fields are also available and MyAccount allows you to define up to 3 levels of cost centres. All reports can be downloaded to CSV or PDF format.

Alert Reports

Allows you to run a report on any triggered alerts within a specific time frame.

CQC will have the ability to keep track of spend and proactively monitor usage. CQC will be able to apply (in real time) device blocks and usage restrictions using MyAccount. MyAccount allows you to view, manage and add usage or event-based alerts for your Mobile services. 'My Alerts' notifies designated contacts by email or SMS of any new call data that meets the criteria contained within a saved search. You can view the status and history of all alerts on MyAccount.

Alert reports are available in CSV format.

Daisy will work with CQC to ensure that the current setup and configuration meets your operational requirements, for example; billing alerts, usage alerts, cost centre structure etc.

Mobile Base Reports

Mobile base reports provide a quick snapshot of Connection number, SIM number, Account Number, Tag (who it's assigned to), Network and assigned Cost Centres.

This report is downloadable in CSV format for further analysis.

My Alerts

View, manage and add usage or event-based alerts for your Mobile and Fixed services. 'My Alerts' notifies you by email or SMS of any new call data that meets the criteria contained within a saved search. You can view the status and history of all alerts on MyAccount.

Types of Alerts

- **Event Alert** - Alerts you to calls lasting over a certain length of time, calls to a particular number (International, premium rate numbers), calls of a particular cost or a call made during a specified period. Exceptions can be added for example if a user needs to call an international customer, their number can be added so that it does not trigger an alert.
- **Usage Alert** - Usage alerts help you monitor usage via cost, duration or amount.

Triggers



Triggers can be set to include cost and duration of minutes, data cost, data usage and MB, duration in minutes and total cost. An alert will be sent to a designated contact when an event is triggered. A single contact or multiple alert contacts can be added and you can manage the contact details or lists at any time.

The following measures can be applied when a high usage limit alert has been triggered on a mobile number;

- Alert Contact/s only,
- Alert contact/s and autobar (no outgoing services) or
- Alert contact/s and autobar (data only).

The bars will automatically reset when the next bill is sent or can be lifted using the manage mobiles section.

This functionality will allow CQC to mitigate any out of bundle usage and take necessary steps to avoid bill shock, e.g., flex up the data bundle. Notification alerts can be generated, based on consumption and cost, with automatic capping also a key function within MyAccount.

Self Service

View account details, manage cost centres and manage your mobile services where applicable. The options available to self-manage your account in this section include:

- **Account Details**

View all account details, activate e-billing, paper billing and update invoice notification email address.

- **Manage Cost Centres**

- Add a new cost centre, move items between cost centres and change the name or amend an existing cost centre.
- Create three level cost centres, move CLI's between existing cost centres and add username (location name) to appropriate CLI.

- **Manage Mobiles**

This is a self-service tool for customers who have mobile services with Daisy. The options available in Manage Mobiles section include:

- Order a replacement SIM card
- Report lost and stolen phones (add a stolen bar to their mobile number and order a replacement SIM card if required).
- Add and remove bars (customer options include: Admin, Stolen, GPRS, Incoming calls, Incoming SMS, International Premium Rate, Premium Calls, Outgoing SMS, Outgoing Roaming)
- Activate new SIM card (activate a new SIM card that was dispatched against specific CLI(s) by Daisy)
- Unlock phones (This section allows customer to obtain the PUK code if their phone has been locked by putting PIN number wrong too many times)
- Manage Worldwide Data Roaming (opt in or opt out from current Worldwide Data Roaming legislation)



- Bulk update numbers (This section allows customer to select mobile numbers they want to bulk update).
- Mobile Bill Limit - define a bill figure/ add a limit (excluding recurring charges).

Support Centre

You can log standard requests via MyAccount. However, we recommend you log support requests via the CSM portal.

Logging requests via our online portals creates a service request into the respective Service Team or assigned Customer Service Executive assigned to you. Once raised the service request will be managed as per our agreed SLA's, all queries including resolution will be discussed at service review meetings.

CSM Portal

The CSM portal is designed to make interactions between our customers and our teams as effective and simple as possible. By providing multiple channels of support and service that are focused upon providing help where it matters most.

The portal provides opportunities for our customers to self-serve via our helpful knowledge articles, as well as traditional capabilities to raise support cases to us that we can interact throughout the lifecycle of the case.

The CSM Portal provides access to the following;

- Request something - raise a service request for APN Management, Bars, PUK code request, Roaming, SIM swaps and Tariff changes.
- Report an Issue - to raise support cases for an incident, request or change to our support teams
- Knowledge base - will take users to the full library of articles allowing them to view and choose by accessing different categories.
- Here to help - Access contact information for your dedicated DCS support team

Portal Training

Daisy can provide training on our portals covering key systems and functions and provide end user instructions and guidance for devices during migration, to help support the solution.

Daisy can provide administrator training for the service portals, billing platforms, reporting tools etc. so that they are able to perform changes and understand the options available. The training will be tailored to your user's needs and can be as simple or advanced as required. Training is free of charge and is available at any point of the contract.

Your Account Manager will be happy to arrange and facilitate training or refresher sessions on MyAccount or CSM Portal.
