Unit Rates

Whilst the core team will be in place to deliver the services in the Statement of Requirements, it is likely that occasionally additional ad hoc services may be required. The intention is that these will be instructed using the change mechanism within the contract. Where possible quotations will be requested based on the Authorities specified requirements and agreed in advance of work commencing; however, time charge basis may be required. Whichever route is taken, the supplier should insert in the yellow cells below the day rates by grade that will be used either as a basis for a fixed fee quotation or on a time charge basis. These rates are to include all items as specified in pricing note 6 of the core team instructions and be the same as the core team rates for the same grades.

For the purposes of evaluation only, these day rates will be multiplied by the number of days shown, resulting in a total for additional services. This element of the pricing is then added to the fixed fee total to result in the Total Contract Price.
