Surgery Location

The surgery is located within the Cannock Chase Commissioning Group. The local council is South Staffordshire District Council.

Essington is a District Ward within South Staffordshire; in the latest Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) (2015) this area was ranked 25,587 out of 32,844 in England, where 1 was the most deprived and 32,844 the least.

Background

Essington Medical Centre is a GP-led health centre which was commissioned by the former South Staffordshire Primary Care Trust (PCT) in 2010. NHS England has decided to offer the contract out for re-tender, again via an APMS contract and the term will be for 5 years. There will be no option to extend beyond this period. NHS England is seeking to identify a provider who will deliver General Medical Services for patients in Essington under an APMS contract only. It should be noted that the practice has received a CQC rating and has an overall rating of good.

Current Contract Position

- The current contractual arrangements will expire on 18th April 2017. It is expected that the new contract will commence on 19th April 2017.
- The incumbent provider practises from fully compliant premises located within the Essington Parish Council complex at Hobnock Road, Essington, WV11 2RF.
- The contract offered will be an Alternative Provider of Medical Services (APMS) agreement
- Contract offer will be for 5 years, with no option to further extend without going through a new tender process.
- APMS contracts will be subject to all relevant Regulations, Directions and Legislation.
- Staff, including Salaried GPs will be subject to TUPE arrangements.

Population in Essington

- According to the 2011 Census, the resident population of Essington was 4,957.
- There is no projected population growth in Essington.
- The Essington Medical Centre was established on 19th April 2010 with a zero list size.
- As at 01/04/16 the incumbent provider had a registered list size of 2,545 (weighted 2,667.02).
- The remaining Essington residents are registered across 16 adjacent GP practices within a radius of 2.4 miles.
