The George V playground in Appleby is situated adjacent to the riverside path and is a two minute walk from the town centre. It is used by both residents and visitors.

The majority of the current playground equipment is between 20-35 years old, very tired looking and in a bad state of disrepair. In addition, some pieces of equipment are located under mature trees and both the equipment and surface are often very slippery and dangerous underfoot.

- Junior multi-play tower
) both should include interactive elements
- Toddler multi-play tower
- Swings
- 2 additional pieces of equipment to compliment other equipment, eg. orbit roundable, rotary bounce, trampoline
- 3 seating/picnic benches, including one suitable for wheelchair users

Attention should be given to ensure that as many elements of the equipment as possible are accessible and inclusive.

We would also like to retain four small pieces of existing equipment, which would need reinstalling.

Although the playground should be designed to fit within the existing footprint, the positioning of the equipment is flexible and the two multi-play systems need to be relocated to the other end, furthest away from the trees.

The quote should also include and itemise the costs of removing all existing wetpour surfaces and installation of appropriate replacement flooring as recommended for both new and retained equipment.
