## 1. About My Coast

My Coast Limited is developing a coastal safety app in collaboration with the RNLI, the MET Office, South West Water and the Universities of Plymouth and Exeter. Our vision is to improve survival rates for coastal incidents and enable better decision making before entering the water or visiting the coast. The platform will also act as a hyperlocal economy, giving users information about the surrounding area, whilst unifying the emergency services with local businesses and the community.

There is a gap in the market for an application that can solve the challenge in the UK of which beach is the right beach for me right now, whilst also making sure that visitors are aware of the dangers, so they can have a trip that is both safe and enjoyable. The key thing here is designing a mobile app experience which is information rich whilst also being user friendly, easy to understand, and simple.

## 2. Background and Context

The project aims to innovate a hyperlocal data platform to sustainably support our economy. The innovation uses local knowledge to assist the local economy. The vision is to create and support a sustainable tourist economy, through delivering key, real-time information promoting safe experiences in a given area.

Since 2010 tourism has been the fastest growing sector in the UK in employment terms. Britain is forecast to have a tourism industry worth over £257 billion by 2025. In 2018, Cornwall's economy was worth £9 billion a year, of which £1.8bn came from tourism. This equated to 4 million visitors that year alone. During the same year, 26 people died accidentally off the county's coastline. This statistic is based on 2018 figures, prior to Covid-19 and the dramatic increase in UK tourism due to travelling restrictions. May 2020 saw 6 coastal deaths in only 8 days. In August 2020, Cornwall was "largely full to current capacity", according to local police. On one weekend, Devon and Cornwall Police saw a 26% increase in 999 callouts compared with 2019. No platform currently integrates real-time data to inform and educate people on the dangers of our coastline.

To date the project has been through a discovery phase involving a workshop with key stakeholders to explore the requirements for the mobile applications. From this a wireframe clickable prototype was developed in Figma, which shows the interactions and general experience that we are looking for. The wireframe will therefore form a key input into the development of the application, but tenderers should not be limited by this initial design.

## 3. Tender requirements

## 4. Budget

The total maximum budget available for this commission is **£50,000** (exc VAT) but inclusive of all expenses.

## Tenders that exceed the total budget will not be considered.

The budget will be reviewed as part of the tender evaluation detailed in Section 10 and will reflect the degree to which there is a saving on the maximum budget

## 6.1 Covering letter to include:

- a. A single point of contact for all contact between the tenderer and MY COAST LIMITED during the tender selection process and for further correspondence.
- **b.** Confirmation that the tenderer has the resources available to meet the requirements outlined in this brief and its timelines
- **c.** Confirmation that the tenderer holds Professional indemnity insurance with a limit of liability of not less than £1 million; if successful, supporting documentation will be provided at the inception meeting.
- d. Conflict of interest statement as per section 8.
- **e.** Confirmation that if successful you can attend the inception meeting as per Section 5.
- 6.2 Project proposal that demonstrates how you will meet the detailed specification, to include project timeline for development.
- 6.3 CVs of the software programmers (maximum 1 side of A4 per CV).
- 6.4 At least two examples of similar commissions. (maximum 2 sides of A4 per example).
- 6.5 Budget, with detailed breakdown.

## 7. Sub-contracting

Tenderers should note that a consortia can submit a tender but the sub-contracting of aspects of this commission after appointment will only be allowed by prior agreement with MY COAST LIMITED.
