Award of contract for the supply of Climate Change Trading Regulatory Services – Lot 1: Our ‘business as usual’ activities

Following your tender/ proposal for the supply of Climate Change Trading Regulatory Services to Environment Agency, we are pleased to award this contract to you.

This letter (Award Letter) and its Annex set out the terms of the contract between The Environment Agency as the Authority and Jacobs UK Limited as the Supplier for the provision of the Services. Unless the context otherwise requires, capitalised expressions used in this Award Letter have the same meanings as in the terms and conditions of contract set out in Annex 1 to this Award Letter (the “**Conditions**”). In the event of any conflict between this Award Letter and the Conditions, this Award Letter shall prevail. Please do not attach any Supplier terms and conditions to this Award Letter as they will not be accepted by the Authority and may delay the conclusion of the Agreement.

For the purposes of the Agreement, the Authority and the Supplier agree as follows:

1. The Services shall be performed primarily home-based, however may be required to attend the office in [REDACTED] periodically.
2. The charges for the Services shall be as set out in the Supplier’s tender dated 15th September 2020.
3. The specification of the Services to be supplied is as set out in the Supplier’s tender dated 15th September 2020 and are embedded within this document:

4. As included within the tender documents, there is no guaranteed level of work under the agreement.
5. The Term shall commence on 23rd November 2020 and the Expiry Date shall be 22nd November 2022. There are two additional extensions options available of 12 months with a final expiry of 22nd November 2024, subject to business requirements, performance and price. All extension requested will be agreed in writing by both parties.

8. The Authority may require the Supplier to ensure that any person employed in the provision of the Services has undertaken a Disclosure and Barring Service check.
