## **Site Clearance and Disposal Services**

## **Q & A Document**

- Q1 Please can the DFT offer any further guidance over the 1100L hazardous waste pricing requirement please you will appreciate the wide variation in potential materials and costs for delivering this element of the service and we want to allow a fair comparison through the process.
  - We appreciate Annex D contains some examples so may we therefore define as a specific hazardous waste stream or simply remove this element from the pricing comparison at this stage?
- A1 We acknowledge a variety of hazardous waste types may need appropriate disposal and they may differ by region. We require Suppliers to provide prices for the Euro bin and van. The actual cost of the waste should be a pass through cost i.e. price paid post disposal.
- Q2 Similarly for skip hire/disposal costs we presume all waste is to be described as general waste for the purpose of the submission.
- A2 The Supplier will need to identify in their methodology, how they will dispose of all of the waste in accordance with legal requirements.
- Q3 As DFT will appreciate there is significant variation in potential costs across the geographical regions which any supplier will need to account for in their costs (for example in Scotland, central belt locations versus Highlands & Islands, West Wales versus South Wales and similarly across different areas of England).
  - Should we use question 2.1.2 (from the Technical Evaluation envelope in Jaggaer) to identify any such issues and qualify our response accordingly or would the DFT prefer to develop the pricing submission further to identify postcode areas or smaller sub-regions so that accurate costs are understood.
- A3 For tendering purposes we remain committed to the 4 regions identified. It is for each Supplier to make a commercial decision on their tenders. The tenders will be the maximum value (£) charge for each region, but a lower charge on a specific site can always be offered.
