

## Saffron Walden Town Council Tree Survey 2016

The Council is seeking companies who wish to undertake a review and to update an existing tree inventory; including replacing lost tags and updating the site plans over an agreed period which fits in with the Councils budget. Alongside this programme to undertake a hazard walkover survey of all sites each year to ensure that no hazards have appeared in the intervening time. This hazard survey would be undertaken at a different time of year to the re-survey to address the problems of missing issues due to trees being in full leaf etc.




