**CONTRACT FOR: Establishing and Operating a Timber Legality Verification Department (LVD) within Liberia's Forest Development Authority(FDA) and Building Capacity within FDA**

**CONTRACT NUMBER: PO 6380**

With reference to the contractual letter dated 23 September 2013 (as most recently amended by the letter of 19 August 2016) whereby your firm was engaged to carry out services as detailed in the Terms of Reference in Annex A, I confirm that the UK Government wishes to make the following further amendments to the letter of 23 September 2013:

**Section 1 - Form of Contract – Paragraph 3**  
**Commencement and Duration of the Services**

**DELETE** 13 October 2018 (“the END date”) and **REPLACE** with 31 July 2019 (“the END date”).

**Section 1 - Form of Contract – Paragraph 4**  
**Financial Limit**

**DELETE** £7,170,383 (“the Financial Limit”) and **REPLACE** with £8,155,214 (“the Financial Limit”)

**Section 5 – Schedule of Prices**

**ADD** Commercial Proformas to supplement existing Commercial Proformas.

Amendment proposal submitted on 25 September 2018 and supplementary Commercial Proformas submitted on 05 October 2018 refer.

These amendments will become effective once the Supplier has executed the local agreement with the Government of Liberia.

1. These amendments relate to (a) a time extension of the contract until 31 July 2019 and (b) an increase in the Financial Limit of the Contract of £984,831 to facilitate the time extension.
2. Please confirm by e-signing within **15 working days** of the date of signature on behalf of DFID that you accept the amendments set out herein.
3. Please note the provision in the contractual letter that the financial limit of the UK Government's liability to the Supplier under this engagement shall not exceed the sum specified unless the amount of any such excess has been agreed by the Department for International Development in writing before the Supplier takes any action which might result in the financial limit being exceeded.
