Surgery Location

The surgery is located within the Stoke on Trent Clinical Commissioning Group. The local council is Stoke on Trent City Council.

Middleport is located in the ward of Burslem Central, in the latest Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) this area was ranked 13,336 out of 32,482 in England, where 1 was the most deprived and 32,482 the least. The area covers 36 hectares where density is 43 people per hectare.

Background

Middleport Medical Centre a GP-led health centre was commissioned by Stoke on Trent Primary Care Trust (PCT) in 2008 as part of the national improving access in primary care programme led by Lord Darzi. The current APMS contract has previously been extended and now expires on 31st March 2016. NHS England has decided to offer the contract out for re-tender, again via an APMS contract and the term will be for 5 years with the option to extend for two plus three years. NHS England is seeking to identify a provider who will deliver General Medical Services for patients of Middleport Medical Centre under an APMS contract only. It should be noted that the practice has received a CQC rating and has an overall rating of good.

Current Contract Position

- The current contractual arrangements will expire at the end of March 2016. It is expected that the new contract will commence on 1st April 2016.

- Contract offer will be for 5 years, with the possibility for extensions of up to a further five years should the commissioner require.
- APMS contracts will be subject to all relevant Regulations, Directions and Legislation
- Staff will be subject to TUPE arrangements

Population Growth in Middleport

There are several residential developments planned for Middleport these are:

- Slater Street - 80 two bed extra care and 62 family homes
- Newport Lane (Former Wood Pottery) - site 86 two/three bed homes
- Travers St/Port Street – 30 homes mix of 1/2/3/4 bed for out-right sale
- Newport Lane (Former Co-op bakery site) outline planning for 103 family homes, although due to expire January 2015
