2	17/01/2018	The pricing spreadsheet appears to specify that appointments should be with a doctor, rather than an occupational health adviser. Please confirm your expectations for the qualifications of those conducting appointments (i.e. Occupational Physician or Occupational Health Adviser).	We expect those conducting appointments to have relevant qualifications, as specified in paragraph 6 of the <u>Service Specification (Qualifications and Experience of OH Staff)</u> or equivalent. The Pricing Schedule distinguishes between doctors and nurses but we are happy for them to be termed an Occupational Physician or an Occupational Health Advisor, or have other professional healthcare qualifications such as a physio or occupational therapist, as long as their qualifications and experience are comparable to a doctor or nurse. If you choose to follow this approach, when answering question 2 (Resourcing delivery of the service), you would need to include information about when a particular type of professional is recommended and what qualifications they have.	18/01/2018
