Hanbury Parish Council Recreation Ground and Play Area project

This project has recently been awarded funding by Wychavon District Council Community Legacy Grant.

The play area review should include infant and junior zoned play areas in which existing pieces of loved equipment can be kept as well as welcoming the installation of new and inclusive equipment appropriate for age and ability.

A new dedicated teenagers' play space should include a MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) with a basketball hoop and other activities conducive with social and physical energies of this age group.

Whilst we also intend to extend the sturdy exercise pathway to cover one whole circuit of the recreation ground as well as installing ten donated pieces of adult exercise equipment, these form no part of this tender.

Below you will find a map of the area, with measurements and questionnaire responses from a survey in 2022.

We expect you to make good site with top soil and grass seed as required and to ensure the management of site is excellent, with Health and Safety, site security, machinery, waste management and delivery.

We also list our specification and expectations of what the area might include and actions needed to be done.

We will require references from two projects your company has completed in the last 12 months.

Our score sheet for the process of selection is added for your assistance.

On-site Welfare Facilities will be made available on site for use during installation dates.

The play area work will be carried out within the current boundaries for the Play Area shown on this plan.

- A budget of £150,000
- A range of age and abilities must be catered for.
- These abilities would not just be about mobility but also hearing and sight loss amongst other conditions to be taken into account.
- The site of the current play area would be the parameters of the proposed play area
- The two willow areas were causing concern because they seemed to attract many wasps and the Parish Council had agreed that they may be taken out.

What needs to be done prior to the build:

The removal and disposal of

- The willow trees/tunnels
- The s/s slide on the mound
- 2 no. existing log trails
- · Other existing equipment not required for future use

Installation ideas for the Infant Zone

- New s/s slide on the mound, 1m wide and 2.5m high
- Horse springers
- Tractor for infants with slide and tunnel
- Inclusive roundabout
- Cradle swings -wooden frame
- Nest swing wooden frame
- 4 -seat see-saw wooden
- Sheltered Picnic bench wooden L 2.4m, W 1.9m, H2m
- Structure to built on mound wooden i.e Castle, Fort, with solid base and to incorporate top of existing wooden steps up the mound and new slide down from mound
- 3 seater benches from recycled material

Installation ideas for the Junior Zone

- · Zip line approx. 25m wooden frame
- An area of wooden structure to accommodate at least ropes, stepping circles, swinging trapeze, rope climb, balance beam - area to cover approx W 3.5m and L 11.5m
- A long swing, wooden frame and rope seating . Seating approx. 6 to 8 children
- 3 seater benches from recycled material

Installation ideas for Teenage Zone - area of approx 11m x 8m

- MUGA fencing, including hoop, goal end 2.4m high, wire mesh and power coated in green
- Activity panels W 1.2 m and H 2.4m
- Perch benches L 2.5 m, wooden seats

Surfaces across the whole Play area where appropriate. Such as:

- Edging needs to be provided where necessary
- Lawn matting
- Rubber safety surfaces
- Concrete paving
- Enviro Pathway surface
