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SERVICES FORM OF AGREEMENT

THIS FORM OF AGREEMENT is made the 27^{th} day of MAY 2015

BETWEEN

- (1) TRANSPORT FOR LONDON a statutory corporation established under the Greater London Authority Act 1999 of Windsor House, 42-50 Victoria Street, London, SW1H 0TL (hereinafter called "the *Employer*" which expression shall include its successors in title and permitted assignees); and
- (2) COSTAIN LTD., a company incorporated in and in accordance with the laws of England and Wales having as its registered number 610201 and its registered office at Costain House, Vanwall Business Park, Maidenhead, Berkshire, SL6 4UB (hereinafter called "the Contractor").

RECITALS

- (A) This Agreement is made pursuant to a framework agreement between Transport for London and the *Contractor* dated **9 April 2013** ("the Framework Agreement").
- (B) The *Employer* wishes to have provided early contractor civil engineering construction planning services associated with the A40 Westway Flyover Project ("the *services*").
- (C) The *Employer* has accepted a proposal by the *Contractor* for the *services* and correction of Defects therein in accordance with the *conditions of contract*.

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

- 1. In this Form of Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, words and expressions shall have the same meaning as set out in the *conditions of contract*.
- 2. The conditions of contract are the NEC Professional Services Contract (Third edition June 2005 with amendments June 2006 and September 2011) together with and as amended by Main Option E, Dispute Resolution Option W2, and Secondary Option Clauses as specified in the Contract Data Part One, Y(UK)2 and Z (being the amendments set out in Schedule 2A to the Framework Agreement).

- 3. This contract shall mean this document and the following documents which are hereby incorporated into and shall comprise this contract:
- 3.1 the *conditions of contract* (including, for the avoidance of doubt, the Option Z clauses set out in Schedule 2A to the Framework Agreement);
- 3.2 the Contract Data Part One;
- 3.3 the Contract Data Part Two;
- 3.4 the Scope; (inclusive of document Ref; STIP/ SMT130/WWW/S1/PR referenced therein)
- 3.5 Schedule 14 of the Framework Agreement;
- 4. The several documents forming this contract are to be taken as mutually explanatory of one another. In the event of any ambiguity they shall be construed in the order set out in Clause 3 of this Form of Agreement.
- 5. The *Contractor* Provides the Services in accordance with this contract.
- 6. The *Employer* pays the *Contractor* for complying with his obligations to Provide the Services the amount due in accordance with this contract.
- 7. Notwithstanding the manner of execution of this contract it is agreed that:
- 7.1 the limitation period within which any claim may be brought by the *Employer* for breach of this contract by the *Contractor* is 12 years from the date of breach; and
- 7.2 the *Contractor* agrees not to raise in defence of any such claim a shorter limitation period whether pursuant to the Limitation Act 1980 (as the same may be amended or re-enacted from time to time) or otherwise.

This Form of Agreement has been executed as a deed and delivered on the date stated at the start of this Form of Agreement.

ECI Services Requirement for Bridges over Thames (STIP 2 – Work Package 1)

Introduction

This ECI services requirement document must be read in conjunction with: "STRUCTURES & TUNNELS INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO A40 WESTWAY STRUCTURES REFURBISHMENT Document Reference; STIP/SMT13013/WW/S1/PR Project Requirements Stage 1 – Outcome Definition"

Requirements/ Objectives

Within the overall Pathway Stage 1 requirements detailed in the above documents, Costain is required to undertake the following.

- 1. Collaborate with other parties to help achieve deliverables;
- 2. Take overall responsibility for delivery of the project;
- 3. Facilitate other parties' deliverables.

The Design Consultant is Ramboll UK Ltd (RUK).

During all aspects of the ECI services Costain is required to work collaboratively with TfL and RUK (the other parties) as part of the project and help them achieve their deliverables.

Each of the tasks described below will require input and agreement with the other parties, however the delivery is the responsibility of Costain. Equally, Costain will input / facilitate other parties' deliverables although they will not be responsible for them.

For clarity, Costain's deliverables from the above documents relate to:

- Programme
- Cost estimates
- Risk evaluation

Programme

Pathway Stage Delivery Programme

Costain is required to provide a programme for the delivery of Pathway Stage 1.

The programme shall identify milestones and deliverables required from other parties to the project, to enable delivery of Pathway Stage 1.

The Stage Programme shall identify when the various elements of Costain's deliverables will be delivered.

Project Programme

Costain shall develop an overall programme for the whole of the project through to Pathway Stage 6.

The durations and activities for subsequent stages shall be agreed with the other members of the project team.

<u>Costs</u>

Pathway Stage 1 Fee Forecast

Costain is required to provide and agree with TfL an agreed fee forecast for the delivery of Pathway Stage 1.

Project Costs

For each of the subsequent stages of the project Costain shall estimate the cost of that stage including each other party's costs inclusive of sub let works and attendances.

The estimate shall form part of a pricing report detailing working methodologies and solutions to the various constraints.

Significant costs are anticipated in the investigative, development and construction stages (Pathway Stages 2-5) of the project. The scope, scale and timing of these subsequent stages shall be agreed within the project team and be allowed for in the pricing report.

The main element of overall cost will be the construction cost; Costain shall estimate the works identified by RUK allowing for likely constraints such as access and traffic management.

Where costs can not be reasonably estimated for specific work items (for any of the work elements with in any stage) then Costain are to advise such, and in place, provide an allowance for the work element together with assumptions.

<u>Risks</u>

Pricing and Programme Risks

During the Pricing and Programming elements various specific risks may be identified that require assessments and assumptions to be made to enable delivery of that scope; Costain shall ensure that these specific risks are to be listed and allowed for within that work element.

Project Risk

Costain shall develop and agree a Project Level Risk Register that includes all Pathway Stages with input from each party. Risks may be subjective (such as reputational) and require specialist input.

The Risk Register shall be quantified and priced.
