- The interest rate on late payment is, unless the provisions of the Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998 otherwise require, 3% per annum above the Bank of England base rate in force from time to time.
- The *Supplier's liability* to the *Purchaser* for indirect or consequential loss, including loss of profit, revenue and goodwill is unlimited.
- The *Adjudicator nominating body* is the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.
- The *tribunal* is arbitration.

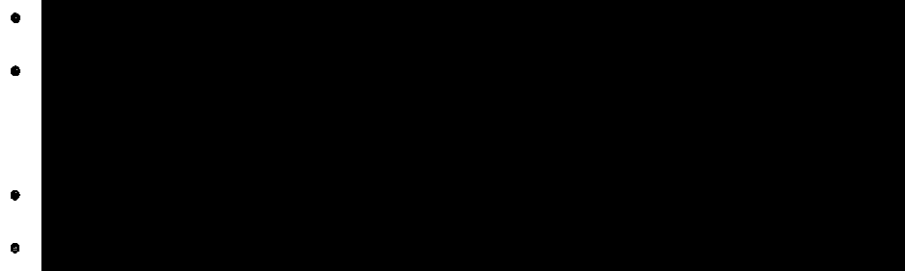
