Soft Market Assessment Town Centre - Vitality Funding Scoping approach

November 2021



Background:

St Austell Town Council aims to be in a strong position to take advantage of future Government funding opportunities to improve St Austell town centre. It is exploring scoping options around how to package a range of support work to deliver a range of outputs. The main areas which we are proposing to group together are:

- Production of a single strategy and masterplan for the town centre
- Development of vision and strategy for the redevelopment of the town centre, agreed by all partners
- A strategy for improving the inclusivity and accessibility of the town centre
- Produce a signage and way marking strategy with deliverable outcomes and costed projects
- Audit of current leisure provision and identification of gaps carried out (for circulation and comment) to establish opportunities for developing the leisure offer in the town centre
- Prioritised list of town centre properties available for re-purposing to be set out in portfolio of deliverable outcomes and costed projects, linked to the other workstreams.

The sum of money allocated to this is £63,000.



In addition we plan to secure as separate packages:

- Creative and cultural events and community engagement an activity calendar of creative and cultural events in the town centre to increase footfall and facilitate community engagement with strong focus on engaging residents, businesses and disability groups (~£31,000)
- Leisure events Delivery of a programme of pop-up leisure events to showcase and test different sports linked to local clubs, or new activities such as gaming, bouldering, urban sports etc. (~£6,500)
- Educational packages Portfolio of deliverable educational outcomes and projects (~£16,500)
- Active transport proposals to enhance active transport (awaiting the production of a Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan by Cornwall Council) (~£24,700)

It is purely investigatory in nature, although it may be used to assist the Town Council in defining both how viable it is as a proposition and a potential preferred procurement route to advance this programme.
