1 **DEFINITIONS**

1.1 In this schedule, the following definitions shall apply:

Monthly Performance Report as set out in Schedule 9- Performance Monitoring.

GFA is a generic term for any MOD asset such as equipment, Assets (GFA) information or resources issued or made available to the Contractor in connection with the Contract by or on behalf of the Authority.

GFE is the generic term for materiel loaned to a contractor. These are tangible items that the contractor must manage and account for.

GFE consists of:

(1) Jigs, Tools and Test Equipment (JTTE) is plant and equipment, jigs, tools, gauges, test equipment, moulds and dies required for DEFCON 23 covers management of JTTE. This does not apply to this contract.

(2) Issued Property is the defined contract term used for all GFE provided to a contractor under DEFCON 611. This applies to this contract.

IOC means the Initial Operating Capability; this aligns with Contract Award.

2 Government Furnished Assets

- 2.1 Appendix A of this Schedule 2 Annex D sets out the descriptions of the items and quantities supplied to deliver the contract.
- 2.2 The terms of the loan are set out as per DEFCON 611 Issued Property.
- 2.3 The GFA will be available to the Service Provider on IOC and will be returned at the end of the contract. Details of this process will be agreed in the Exit Management Plan.
- 2.4 GFE will be stored and held at SDW Halton and SDW Sennybridge, the responsibility of the equipment will be held with the Service Provider as detailed in Schedule 2 Annex A Statement of Requirement.
- 2.5 All items are to be fit for purpose and serviceable when issued for use. To ensure the Authority maintains sufficient serviceable stock to meet the delivery output of the contract of work. It is the responsibility of the Service Provider to report to the Authority any clothing or equipment that is no longer serviceable by placing the item into quarantine and if deemed unusable it is then destroyed. A weekly sitrep must be provided to allow the SDW to prepare clothing/equipment for repair/replacement, for following weeks activities. The Authority will then arrange for repair or replacement of the item(s) as necessary.
