

SCHEDULE 18 - GOVERNMENT FURNISHED ASSETS (GFA)

Introduction

1. This Schedule should be read in conjunction with Contract Schedule 2 (Statement of Requirements).
2. This Schedule details the Government Furnished Assets that the Authority shall provide to the Contractor to enable the Contractor to deliver the outputs required by the Contract.
3. Without prejudice to Schedule 1 (Definitions and Interpretations), for the purposes of this Schedule 18, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

Term	Definition
Government Furnished Resources (GFR)	Means the Authority funded personnel provided by the Authority to the Contractor to provide Services in accordance with this Contract.
Issued Property	Means Government Furnished Asset (GFA) which is issued to the Contractor under the terms of DEFCON 611 (Issued Property).
Low Value Equipment	Means Authority owned Assets, other than Issued Property, under the value of £5000 which are to be used in the delivery of the Services.

Government Furnished Resources (GFR)

4. The Authority shall provide GFR to the Contractor in accordance with Schedule 2 (Statement of Requirements).
5. For GFR, specific conditions at clause 35 (Use of Authority Personnel) of this Contract shall apply.

Period of Availability

6. All Issued Property listed in the SOR will be provided from the Service Commencement Date until the earlier of the Expiry Date or the Termination Date, or an earlier date agreed between the Authority and the Contractor should the Contractor, at its discretion, choose to return an item to provide Services in accordance with this Contract.

Other Assets

7. The Authority shall provide Low Value Equipment for use by the Contractor for the Contract Period. No later than six months following Service Commencement Date the Contractor shall have compiled a list of Low Value Equipment into the Contractor's asset management system. The Contractor shall then maintain the list of Low Value Equipment on behalf of the Authority for the Contract Period.
