- 1A.3.1 The Supplier must provide Services to produce the Deliverables set out in this Schedule or as otherwise mutually agreed in writing between the Buyer and the Supplier during this Statement of Work.
- 1A.3.2 **Website development:** development of a website platform for e-Bug and its partner country micro-sites, branded using the logos and branding schematic that is an output of SOW ECM_7637 PHE Corporate ICT e-Bug and incorporating WCAG2.1 AA standards
- 1A.3.3 **User testing:** this will include survey, feedback, and virtual webinar event.
- 1A.3.4 **Promotion:** Development of two promotional pieces, one animation and one video.

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- 1A.3.5 Agile ceremonies are to be conducted together at a frequency to be mutually agreed between Buyer and Supplier, these shall include but not be limited to:
 - Sprint planning meetings;
 - Show and tells for design ideas and user feedback
 - Retrospectives including action plans; and
 - Meetings with the PHE project team (frequency to be confirmed).

Sch 1A.4 Call-Off Contract Charges

- 1A.4.1. For each individual Statement of Work (SOW), the applicable Charges will be calculated using all of the following:
- the agreed relevant rates for Supplier staff or facilities, which are inclusive of any applicable expenses and exclusive of VAT were submitted to the Buyer not costed at market value but costed at a flat consultancy rate of . This represents a reduction of per day against the Supplier's usual charitable rate.
- the number of days, or pro rata for every part of a day, that Supplier staff or facilities will be actively providing the Services during the term of the SOW are estimates of the time the Supplier consider each would take.
- a contingency of up to 10% of total excl VAT to accommodate any changes to the SOW Deliverables during the term of the SOW. The Supplier must obtain prior written approval from the Buyer before applying any contingency.

a. Assumptions:

- 1. The Supplier will undertake upskilling and knowledge transfer to PHE project team members as and when required during discovery (if applicable).
- 2. The Supplier must participate in stakeholder meetings. This may include, but is not limited to, regular show and tells and other agile ceremonies.

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- 3. The deliverables detailed in 1A.3.2 to 1A.3.5 are based on best known information and might change dependent on number of resources etc.
- 4. Unless mutually agreed otherwise the budget of £27,275 does not include the provision for project expenses. The Supplier does not currently anticipate the need to incur any expenses to deliver this work. Expenses must be in line with the Buyers expense policy and must be agreed upfront.
- 5. All Intellectual Property Rights in and arising out of or in connection with the Schedule of Work shall be owned by PHE

b. Risks:

- 1. Failure by either party to respond / meet in timely fashion leading to failure to meet established timelines.
- 2. Failure to establish a clear project plan that establishes expectations and reduces opportunity for project creep.
- 3. Failure to define expectations for product at commencement of project.
