1. You are hereby informed of the Department's requirement and you are invited to accept the Offer of the Contract, in accordance with the references above, details of which are set out in the attached Modifications Contracting Form (MCF) - Issue 1. The MCF describes the requirements and sets out the contract terms and conditions which will take effect upon acceptance by you of the Department's offer.
2. Pending agreement of the price to be paid, the Authority is prepared to fix a pegged price, in accordance with and subject to Clause 2 of DEFCON 127 (Edn 12/14) of [REDACTED] in addition to a L of L agreed at [REDACTED] for the above package of work. This price for Item 2 is pegged on the basis that the Capital Service Adjustment element of the profit rate and the 2018 / 2019 labour rates are pegged at the currently agreed rate, these may be subject to change should a rate be agreed between the Authority and the Contractor. All other costs are agreed as firm and will not be subject to change. This price is agreed without prejudice to any future negotiation on this or any other Ministry of Defence Contract
3. As signatory to the Montreal Protocol on Substances that deplete the ozone layers, Her Majesty's Government is committed to the reduction of the production and consumption of those substances controlled under the Protocol. Therefore, Her Majesty's Government wishes to know which substances at Appendix 1 of the Contract are contained in the Articles the subject of this Offer of Contract. If you wish to accept this offer, please return a signed Modifications Contracting Form - Issue 1 and a completed Montreal Protocol return as detailed at paragraph 3 to the Department at the address shown above by post within 5 working days. Your Acceptance of the Department's offer must be unqualified. If you do not accept the Department's offer within the period specified, then the Department's offer shall lapse.
  5. When you have accepted the Department's offer in accordance with paragraph 4 above, you should proceed with the performance of the Contract.
