- THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR HOUSING, COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT and whose offices are located at: Fry Building, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 4DF acting as part of the Crown (the "Client"); and
- JACOBS UK LIMITED which is a company incorporated in and in accordance with the laws of England and Wales (Company No. 02594504 whose registered office address is at Cottons Centre, Cottons Lane, London, SE1 2QG (the "Consultant").

BACKGROUND

- (A) The Minister for the Cabinet Office (the "Cabinet Office") as represented by Crown Commercial Service, a trading fund of the Cabinet Office, without separate legal personality (the "Authority"), established a framework for construction professional services for the benefit of public sector bodies.
- (B) The *Consultant* was appointed to the framework and executed the framework agreement (with reference number RM6165) which is dated 01 October 2021 (the "**Framework Agreement**"). In the Framework Agreement, the Consultant is identified as the "Supplier".
- (C) On the 15th November 2024 the *Client*, acting as part of the Crown, and in the Framework Agreement is identified as a "Contracting Authority" invited the *Consultant* along with other framework suppliers to tender for the *Client's* construction professional team services requirements in accordance with the Call Off Procedure (as defined in the Framework Agreement).¹
- (D) On the 11th December 2024 the *Consultant* submitted a tender response and was subsequently selected by the *Client* to provide the *service*.
- (E) The *Consultant* has agreed to Provide the Services in accordance with this agreement and the Framework Agreement.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The *Client* will pay the *Consultant* the amount due and carry out his duties in accordance with the *conditions of contract* identified in the Contract Data and the Contract Schedules.
- 2. The *Consultant* will Provide the Service in accordance with the *conditions* of *contract* identified in the Contract Data and the Contract Schedules.
- 3. This contract incorporates the conditions of contract in the form of the NEC4 Professional Services Contract June 2017 Edition incorporating amendments January 2019 and October 2020 and incorporating the following Options:
