1.0 Introduction

Global OTEC Resources Ltd specialises in the design and development of ocean thermal energy conversion technology.

The company now wishes to procure Project Management services for a project that will potentially be part-financed by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) through the Marine-I Challenge Fund.

2.0 Project Information

Project Title: Detailed design of floating OTEC plant pipelines

Project Description: This is a business-led research and development project designed to develop Ocean Thermal Electrical Conversion pipeline technology.

Project Location: The project will be located in Cornwall, an Article 107(3)(a) Assisted Area under the UK Assisted Areas Map established for the period 2014 to 2020 and as defined under Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 Article 90.

3.0 Scope of Works

GOR wishes to procure the services of a marine sector engineering and technology company or sole trader to project manage the detailed design of a novel offshore OTEC water piping system. The project manager must lead the team and subcontractors to design a system that meets all relevant, current regulations and standards. The project manager will be responsible for the delivery of an accurate, on-budget capital cost for the fabrication of cold, warm and discharge water pipes.

The suppliers should be in an existing NDA (Non-disclosure agreement) with Global OTEC Resources Ltd. or be willing to sign an NDA and to receive confidential information.

An NDA pre-signed by Global OTEC Resources Ltd is part of the bidding documents. Bidders who are not in an NDA please sign the NDA and return to dan.grech@otecresorts.com. The relevant confidential information will be supplied within the same date/or the next morning by 10:00.

The supplier must be able to demonstrate their technical experience in project management for novel offshore components and provide evidence of 3 similar projects undertaken in the last 2 years.

The supplier must have worked on previous R&D projects relating to OTEC systems. Please note this is a Qualifying Criteria.

The anticipated budget for the works detailed here is £32,000 excl. VAT.

The supplier must work from GOR's Cornwall office five days a week for a period of six months.
