

LEGEND:

Dashed line shows extent of components that are required to be removed and disposed.



Hatched line shows extent of existing partitions to be removed and disposed down to existing floor level.



Hatched area indicates extent of wall to be removed to allow for new disabled WC access.

FEMALE WC:

- -Existing partition walls to be removed. Allow to make good existing partition on Disabled WC following demolition.
- -Existing windows to be removed and disposed of. Allow to infill as per specification.
- -Dispose of sanitary ware and associated drainage pipe work.
- -Dispose of existing cubicles and vanity units.
- -Dispose of existing splash back tiles and adhesive.
- -Dispose of all wall mounted fixtures i.e. soap/towel dispensers, hand dryers, mirrors, coat hooks, curtains and signs in female WC. Allow to check with client prior to disposal.
- -Allow for licensed contractor to remove and dispose of asbestos containing floor tiles below vanity unit. Please refer to **asbestos** survey.
- -All floor coverings, tiles and skirting boards to be removed throughout female bathrooms and main corridor.
- -Please refer to the Mechanical and Electrical drawings and specification.
- -Remove and dispose of all door sets.
- -Allow to remove and dispose of existing plasterboard ceiling throughout, including associated redundant services.
- -Rub down all walls to redecorate.

MALE WC:

- -Existing partition walls to be removed. Allow to make good where required.
- -Dispose of sanitary ware and associated drainage pipe work.
- -Dispose of existing cubicles and vanity units.
- -Dispose of existing splash back tiles and adhesive.
- -Existing external wall to be knocked through to allow for installation of door set.
- -Dispose of all wall mounted fixtures i.e. soap/towel dispensers, hand dryers, mirrors, coat hooks, curtains and signs in male WC. Allow to check with client prior to disposal.
- -Allow for a licensed contractor to remove **asbestos** textured coating and plasterboard back to joists in main corridor ceiling.
- -All floor coverings, tiles and skirting boards to be removed throughout male bathrooms and main corridor.
- -Please refer to the Mechanical and Electrical drawings and specification.
- -Remove and dispose of all door sets.
- -Allow to remove and dispose of existing plasterboard ceiling throughout, including associated redundant services.
- -Rub down all walls to redecorate.
