#### What is the maximum height the glass and door can be?

We typically install up to a height of 3000mm, any higher and the integrity of the glass is significantly reduced.

#### How wide is a panel of glass?

We typically install panels between 650mm and 850mm, in the technical survey we will ensue each panel of the partition looks the same width.

#### I want to proceed, what are the next steps?

Give us a call or send us an e-mail and we can get the ball rolling. Once you have given us the go ahead, we will send you an e-mail including a checklist and a link for the Technical Survey Fee.

### Will you manufacture off my measurements?

No, our professional surveyor will always visit the site to take accurate measurements with a laser. After surveying, we will send a drawing with the layout design and measurements for your approval before manufacturing.

#### What happens if there is data trunking or pipework?

Not a problem, we have a number of solutions for obstructions including 'notching' the glass, cutting the track work around and the use of packing pieces.

#### Can you install into a suspended ceiling?

Yes, the majority of our installation are into suspended ceilings.

## What colour is the perimeter track?

We can do any colour RAL, however our standard and therefore quickest lead time RAL colours are: RAL 9005 (Black), RAL 9006 (Silver), RAL 9010 (White) and RAL 7016 (Anthracite).

#### What is the lead time?

Our typical lead time is 2-4 weeks, though some specialised materials can take up to 8 weeks.

#### Will the glass be fire rated?

Our standard glass partitioning is non fire rated, however, we do offer fire rated products ranging from E30 to E160. Fire glass requires sign off from building control on the exact rating needed.

# Will the glass be soundproof?

Installing a glass wall or partition will always reduce noise transfer between rooms. However, we offer various types of glass with different acoustic properties. Clients should note that sound can also travel through suspended ceilings and bounce off hard surfaces.

# I have an uneven ceiling, can I still install a glass partition?

Yes, absolutely! The surface area of the uneven sections will determine the most cost-effective option. For old buildings with uneven ceilings, we typically measure each glass panel individually to account for height discrepancies. Alternatively, we can install a deeper perimeter channel to absorb the ceiling's undulations.


