

## **BACKGROUND**

In April 15 the MOD signed a contract with Leidos Europe Ltd to provide the procurement and inventory management of commodity items (as well as the storage and distribution services) historically provided in-house by the Logistic Commodities and Services Operating Centre. Leidos, working with the MOD, will transform the way these services are delivered to ensure requirements continue to be met whilst providing best value for money for the department. The organisation delivering these services is known as Team Leidos.

## **FUTURE ARRANGEMENTS**

Team Leidos would like to make interested suppliers aware that it intends to invite tenders for its Patient controlled analgesia system requirement later this year, with a view to awarding Contracts that will commence late 2017/early 2018 for approximately 180 IT tablets.

Team Leidos require these to be shipped to our main operational distribution hub in Donnington, Telford within normal industry lead times.

## **KEY USER REQUIREMENT**

Please let us know if you can meet the requirements listed below

### **Tablet Requirements**

- Operating system - Android KitKat or above
- Max unit size 275 mm x 200 mm x 8.5 mm
- Min size screen - 260mm x 100 mm
- Bluetooth capability which can be switched off
- No WI FI needed
- Must charge via USB without mains power.
- Must be CE Marked
- Memory not important - 8mb acceptable
- Battery life must be 9+hours
- Weight of unit must be <550g
- IP rating must be IP65 or more
- Must be suitable for all environmental conditions, and work in temperatures up to 45 degrees centigrade
- Monitor or packaging must prevent ingress of matter and moisture
