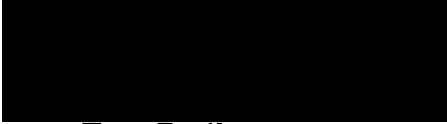
This covering letter sets out the particulars of the Calldown Contract regarding the aforementioned matter.
