

On behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport, the Department would like to vary this agreement in line with the Crown Commercial Service RM1557:11 GCloud 11 Framework. This letter and the documents listed below form a binding contract between you and the Department for Transport.

The contract term will remain unchanged having commenced on 01 October 2019 and due to expire on 30 September 2021 with a further 24-month extension options available as per framework provision.

The original contract was awarded for £2,500,000 and this variation is to extend the available funds within the call off to allow additional works to be completed (as captured in your proposal). These works will take the overall contract value up to £3,750,000 which is the maximum permissible under Public Contracts Regulations.
