Re: St John Ambulance (SJA) contract extension to contract: SJA Volunteer Workforce – Plus MTC + Housebound contract extension

Further to our recent discussions with you, NHSEI is looking to extend the term of its contract with SJA for the provision of the management of volunteers to support the Covid-19 and Flu Vaccine Deployment Programme for a further 6 months. The contract extension will be effective from 22nd June 2022 and the new contract term will expire on 21st December 2022. The contract will continue on the same terms as the current Service Contract, which was renewed in December 2021 under the title: SJA Volunteer Workforce – Plus MTC + Housebound contract extension.

In order to effect the contract extension, the provisions in clause 2 of Schedule 1 of the Service Contract will be deleted and replaced with "the Contract term will expire on 21st December 2022".
