Description	Details
Subject matter of the processing	The processing is needed in order to ensure that the Supplier can effectively deliver the contract. The contract requires the supplier to provide training and coaching services to individuals and businesses.
Duration of the processing	Data will be processed for a period of up to 30 months from the start of the contract. We expect this period to be between April 2023 and September 2025.
Nature and purposes of the processing	The supplier will be required to track the identity of individuals within business that have completed an online diagnostic as part of their early engagement with business support. At the heart of the design of the platform is the requirement to deliver a simple and intuitive user interface. It is a series of questions about all areas of their business – from objective questions about processes the company has in place, to asking the users opinions about how various aspects of the business work. The Innovation and Growth Specialist receives a notification confirming when all respondents have completed the questionnaire, reports are provided to the respondents and the advisor in a suitable format e.g. PDF. The Supplier will need to provide face to face training for Innovate UK EDGE partners and Innovation Growth Specialists in use of the tool. This will involve the collection, recording, organisation, retrieval, and consultation of personal data pertaining to individuals who attend the needs analysis training.

	The Supplier will be required to provide regular reports to the Contracting Authority on the progress of the contracted service. This will require the sharing of personal data between the Supplier and the Contracting Authority. The Supplier will be required to evaluate the outreach and impact of the contracted service. This may include contacting individuals within the businesses to conduct surveys or interviews. This process will involve the retrieval and consultation of previously recorded personal data. Any additional personal data collected through surveys or interviews will be stored, organised and may be shared with the Contracting Authority for the purposes of assessment and evaluation.
