Contract Modification Notice – Extension of Grounds Maintenance and Waste Management Contract with Idverde UK Limited

2. Original Contract Details

Contract Value: £3,027,311.00

3. Description of Modification

The contract for the provision of grounds maintenance and waste management services is being extended for a further period of two years, from 02 July 2025 to 01 July 2027.

This modification is made in accordance with Regulation 72(1)(c) of the Public Contracts Regulations 2013. The extension is required due to unforeseen circumstances, specifically delays in preparing for a re-procurement process caused by internal resource constraints and the cost implications of engaging external consultants.

4. Legal Basis for Modification

Regulation 72(1)(c) permits modification of contracts during their term without a new procurement procedure where:

- The need for the modification has been brought about by circumstances which a diligent contracting authority could not have foreseen;
- The modification does not alter the overall nature of the contract; and
- Any increase in price does not exceed 50% of the value of the original contract.

The Council confirms that all these conditions are met in this case.

5. Value of the Modification

Value of Modification: £1,504,808.76 (excluding VAT)

Percentage Increase Relative to Original Contract: 49.7% (within the 50% limit permitted under Regulation 72(1)(c) of the Public Contracts Regulations 2013).

7. Justification for Modification

The extension will:

- Provide continuity of essential public services during a transitional period;
- Avoid disruption to services critical to public health and safety;

- Allow sufficient time for a compliant, competitive re-procurement process.
