Invitation to Tender

Commercially licensed vessel, trailer, punt and outboard

Ref: IOSVS 082

1 Background

I am looking to establish a new pleasure boat business on the Isles of Scilly offering trips to the various Islands.

The commissioning of this work is part of a grant funded application process and therefore procurement will be subject to grant approval of the project as a whole. We will compare tenders received on a compliance basis only.

2 Project Specification

The business aims to be fully operational by April 6th 2021. Therefore, all purchases will need to be sourced and delivered to the Isles of Scilly in 'good time' by April 6th 2021.

Purchases required:

The principal purchase of the start-up business will be a **commercially licensed vessel**. The vessel will have to meet strict specifications as listed below:

- Minimum overall length of 31ft
- A draft less than or equal to 0.92m
- Have a minimum beam of 3.3m
- Have a semi-displacement hull
- Have a hull composite of fibreglass (GRP)
- Have been built no earlier than 1994
- Commercially licensed to carry a maximum of 12 passengers
- Have adequate and comfortable seating for 12 passengers outside/ on the deck of the vessel
- Have sufficient indoor/ cabin space to house passengers when weather demands
- Fully equipped to be helmed by one person note no crew required
- Be suitably designed to operate effectively and safely in and around the open waters of the Isles of Scilly
- Have two inboard diesel engines (for safety and manoeuvrability purposes)
- Have a minimum speed of 14 knots and a maximum speed of 18 knots
- Be fitted with commercial standard radar, vhf radio and chart plotters
- Vessel must be in date of an MCA 5 year hull survey

A **trailer** for the vessel will be required. The trailer must have the ability to:

- Launch and retrieve the vessel from Porthloo slipway on St. Mary's
- Store the vessel during the winter months at Porthloo Boatyard
- Provide adequate working access to the vessel to ensure the vessel can be winterised and that all winter maintenance can be carried out effectively

A punt and outboard will be required to gain access to the principal vessel. Punt must:

- be of 10ft length minimum
- house a suitably powered outboard ≥ 5hp

The tender will be scored only on their compliance to the specification set out in section 2 and awarded to the lowest compliant tender.
