This agreement is made on 11 May 2023

On behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport, I am writing regarding the agreement made on 14 October 2020 between the Department for Transport ("the Employer") and CPC Project Services LLP ("the Supplier") regarding the above work package order.

I can confirm that the agreement has now been varied in **Time and Value**. The agreement will continue in accordance with the same terms and conditions as specified in the original agreement of 14 October 2020. This contract has been extended from 18 October 2023 to now conclude on **18 October 2024**. Additionally, the value of the contract has been increased by **£75,000**, and therefore, the new total value of the contract is up to a maximum of **£225,000**.

The Supplier's services under this Work Package Order will continue to be charged on a Time Charge Option E as governed by the NEC4 Professional Services Contract June 2017.

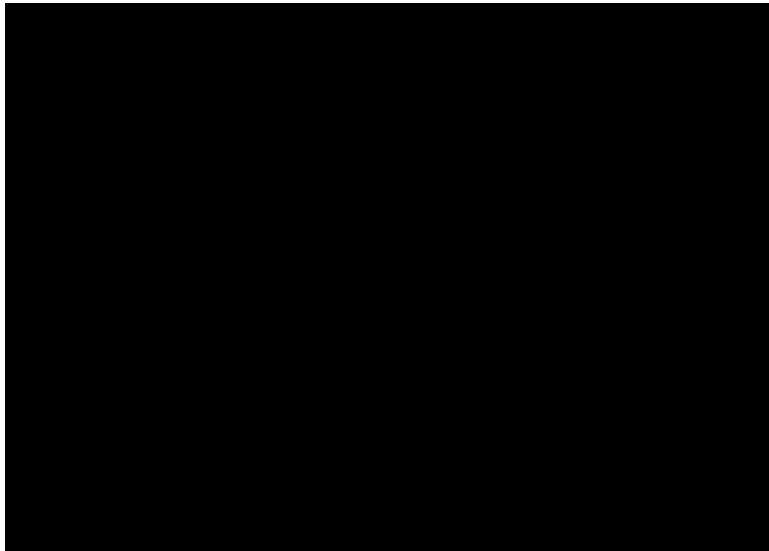
