

Section 13 GDPR Data Breach Reporting Process & Form

As part of the GDPR the Vendor must establish a data breach reporting arrangements process.

Where the vendor is processing data on behalf of RBC ie the Data Controller, it has a duty to report data breaches to the controller such that the controller can report to the Information Commissioner's Office within 72 hours of discovering the breach.
