

- 1) Interior view of information counter showing the usual arrangement of accessories and equipment. Note the important aspect of an obstruction free area below the desk to allow a sideways chair movement between the info pass tray and microphone and the computer screen / printer to its left.
- 2) Externally, the counter projects forward with all leading edges rounded and the below counter area filled with the equivalent radiused faces. It is at an ideal height for users of wheelchairs.
- 3) Our Bus Station Controllers and Customers have a direct face to face relationship via security glass and an intercom. The most important information is on display and can be passed through the security tray.
- 4) Counter window located to give a favourable overall view of the bus station and in itself be visible to our customers.
