ONGOING MAINTENANCE

TAXUS BACCATA - Pollution tolerant and of well drained soil. No regular pruning necessary but can be trimmed and shaped as preferred. Beware poisonous red berries in Autumn on female specimens.

FAGUS SYLVATICA - Prune in late winter / early spring. Beware little pruning is required as hard pruning may cause more damage to growth with plants with non-vigorous stems. Light pruning meaning, the removal of branches growing in unwanted directions, disease or damaged areas. Beech is at risk of Coral Spot disease in the heart and root of mature trees. Best suited to well drained soil.

PRUNUS LAUROCERASUS - Beware leaves can be harmful if ingested. Once established, evergreens need fairly little maintenance. Evergreen shrubs should be pruned in mid - late spring after risk of frost has passed. Aim to remove 1/3 of the old wood. After pruning, the plant benefit from mulch or feed. This can be all purpose or rose or high-potassium fertiliser. Best suited to well drained soil.

CRATAEGUS MONGYA - Requires similar, minimal pruning as Fagus sylvaticus, both being in deciduous pruning category. Be aware fruit may cause mild stomach upset if ingested. Best suited to well drained soil.
