

Spark Collaboration is a unique software as service (SaaS) platform based on insights from network science that helps organizations connect their employees to share ideas that lead to greater innovation, productivity, and engagement.

The following represents the Agreement for BEIS to license the use of Spark Collaboration from Trackmind Solutions.

The following terms govern service level agreements related to support requested by BEIS:

- 1. Deletion Requests BEIS personnel will send within 5 working days of the end of each month, and Spark will complete within 10 working days of receipt.
- 2. Account Status Updates (reactivating accounts that are showing as bounced) BEIS personnel will send within 5 working days of the end of each month, and Spark will complete within 10 working days of receipt.
- 3. Monthly Feedback Reports BEIS personnel will receive them within 10 working days, following the end of each month.
- 4. Ad Hoc Requests BEIS and Spark will review each request and agree on course of action together with completion dates, which Spark will abide by.

Account Information/user content:

Name, password, and email address, and optionally description, profile picture, and/or social media handles. This information is provided directly by the data subject.

The legitimate basis for processing a data subject's personal information is their consent.

Spark receives and records information from a user's web browser when they interact with the service, including a user's IP address and cookie information. This information is used for fighting spam/malware and also to facilitate collection of data concerning a user's interaction with the service.

Cookies are used to enable Spark to recognize a user's web browser and tell the system how and when a user visits the site and use the Services through the Internet.

Spark's data is housed in the Amazon Cloud, none of it is held on premises.

Spark use several types of scanning tools, including Qualys Web App Scanning to check for security vulnerabilities on the platform. Access to their servers hosted at Amazon is IP restricted to two locations.

	Spark confirms that their processes and Privacy Policy reflect the standards established by GDPR.
Duration of the Processing	From 1/6/2022 to 30/11/2023, or as extended by mutual agreement
Nature and purposes of the Processing	The nature of the processing means any operation such as the collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction of data (whether or not by automated means) etc.
	The purpose of the processing is to randomly match participants in the BEIS and Civil Service Coffee Connect Schemes on a regular basis, so they can contact each other and share ideas and experiences.

erase from any computers, storage devices and storage media that are to be retained by the Contractor after the expiry of the Contract.
The Contractor will certify to the Authority that it has completed such deletion.
