<b>Requirement Summary</b>	A review of the institutional arrangements and accountabilities for the governance and oversight of cyber resilience in the financial sector and in particular its critical national infrastructure (CNI), focusing on responsibilities within the Financial Authorities for the assurance of the sector's cyber resilience, and roles elsewhere within government, particularly where there is potential overlap with the Financial Authorities.

<b>Non-financial Value Statement</b>	The expected outcome of the review would be an assessment of existing governance structures and specific, actionable recommendations to ensure clear lines of responsibility and accountability and to reduce any overlap, and to improve understanding within the official sector (and ultimately more widely within industry). This would form the basis for further advice to Ministers on how responsibilities for the assurance of the resilience of cyber CNI in the sector might best be shared. It may also identify more general lessons that might be helpful for other departments seeking to strengthen cyber resilience in other critical infrastructure sectors.
