## 2. Background

2.1 The border is a critical line of defence and of fundamental importance to UK security and economic prosperity. The Buyer must ensure effective border controls are in place to facilitate flow of legitimate passengers and trade from overseas easily and efficiently.

2.2 The border is the primary point of interception to deter, detect and disrupt threats to UK security from hostile groups and prevent wide-ranging illicit activities, including terrorism, serious and organised crime, illegal migration and evasion of excise duties and cross-border crime.

2.3 The Buyer uses a broad range of detection methods and capabilities to detect diverse threats, including use of several screening technologies. The equipment used by front-line officers for detecting threats is a critical component of the Buyer's detection capability and must be fit for purpose to ensure that the UK keeps pace with evolving challenges and threats driven by serious organised crime groups (OCGs), and to maintain critical operations 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.
