
The Contract Module enables authorised users to integrate contract information into the Cloud Marketplace and the supplier portal. The module supports local contracts in place between a supplier and its preferred buyers, as well as contracts governed by procurement groups or framework Coordinators. The features of this module will enable a supplier to ensure the products in their catalogues are assigned to the correct contracts, and that this contract information can then guide end users within buying organisations to buy from contracted suppliers as well as delivering contract analysis at various stages of the procurement process.

How to access the module

Permissions to access the Contract module are controlled at user level within your organisation. If you have access to load in prices you will be assigned the Contract Module permission.

To access the module, select "Contract module" on the left-hand tool bar of your home page.



Contract Types

The Contract Module supports local contracts as well as frameworks:

Local - Local contracts that are a one-to-one agreement between yourselves and a buyer can be created by either you or the buying organisation, however if created by the supplier,

please note that there is an approval process in place for the buyer to accept or reject the contract.

Frameworks - Frameworks need to be chosen by a supplier from the selection provided on the module, which will have been implemented by Advanced and provided by the relevant framework coordinator. Advanced will be keeping the framework lists up to date where we are able to.
