All buses operating on the Services must serve all stops on the line of route designated for the route.

Drivers must pick up/set down at all bus stops where passengers wish to board and/or alight. If a driver is certain no passengers wish to board or alight, they may continue. If the driver is in any doubt, they must stop.

## **ROUTE 333: Tooting Broadway – Elephant & Castle**

**Date of Structural Change:** 20 January 2024.

**Date of Service Change:** 20 January 2024.

**Reason for Issue:** New Contract.

### **STREETS TRAVERSED**

**Towards Elephant & Castle:** Mitcham Road, Southcroft Road, Mitcham Lane, Streatham High Road, Streatham Hill, Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Clapham Road, Kennington Park Road, Newington Butts, Elephant and Castle, Newington Causeway

**Towards Tooting Broadway:** Newington Causeway, Elephant and Castle, Newington Butts, Kennington Park Road, Clapham Road, Stockwell Road, Brixton Road, Brixton Hill, Streatham Hill, Streatham High Road, Mitcham Lane, Southcroft Road, Mitcham Road

### **AUTHORISED STANDS, CURTAILMENT POINTS, & BLIND DESCRIPTIONS**

Please note that only stands, curtailment points, & blind descriptions as detailed in this contractual document may be used.

#### **Tooting Broadway, Longmead Road**

Public stand for five buses in Longmead Road in three parts:

1. On north side of Longmead Road for three buses, commencing at a point 11 metres south of No 2 Longmead Road and extending 30 metres.
2. In the centre of Longmead Road for one bus.
3. On south side of Longmead Road for one bus, commencing at a point 14 metres east of eastern building line of Mitcham Road and extending 10 metres.

Buses proceed from Mitcham Road, Longmead Road to stand, departing via Longmead Road to Mitcham Road.

Set down in Mitcham Road - A217, at Stop R (BP5405 - Tooting Broadway Station) and pick up in Mitcham Road - A217, at Stop C (29686 - Mitcham Road / Tooting Broadway Stn).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 2 buses on Route 333 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Tooting Broadway.
OTHER INFORMATION:	Council toilet facilities are available 24 hours a day.

### **Streatham, St Leonard's Church (from Elephant & Castle)**

Buses proceed from Mitcham Lane, Ambleside Avenue, Tooting Bec Gardens departing to Streatham High Road.

Set down in Mitcham Lane, at Stop SL (12803 - Streatham / St Leonard's Church) and pick up in Streatham High Road, at Stop O (25857 - Becmead Avenue).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	<b>Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand</b>
BLIND DISPLAY:	Streatham, St. Leonard's Church.

### **Streatham Hill, Telford Avenue (from Elephant & Castle)**

Public stand for one bus on west side of Streatham Hill, opposite Wavertree Road.

Buses proceed from Streatham Hill to stand, departing to Streatham Hill.

Set down in Streatham Hill, at stop BH (R0417 - Streatham Hill / Christchurch Road) and pick up in Streatham Hill, at stop TA (R0420 - Telford Avenue).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Streatham Hill, Telford Avenue.

### **Clapham Park, Atkins Road (from Elephant & Castle)**

Offside public stand on the north side of Atkins Road immediately west of the junction with Kings Avenue and extending 50 metres west.

Buses proceed from Brixton Hill direct to stand, departing to Atkins Road.

Set down in Brixton Hill, at Stop BF (2398 - Holmewood Road) and pick up in Brixton Hill, at Stop BT (2397 - Holmewood Road).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Brixton Hill, Christchurch Road.

**Stockwell Station, Clapham Road (from Tooting Broadway)**

Buses proceed from Stockwell Road, Binfield Road, Lansdowne Way, South Lambeth Road, Clapham Road departing to Stockwell Road.  
Set down in Stockwell Road, at stop R (509 - Stockwell Gardens) and pick up in Stockwell Road, at stop X (534 - Stockwell Gardens).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	<b>Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand</b>
BLIND DISPLAY:	Stockwell.

**Brixton, Lambeth Town Hall, Effra Road (from Elephant & Castle)**

Public stand for 3 buses on west side (offside) of Effra Road, commencing 30 metres south of lamp standard No 2498 opposite p/w Nos.9/11, and extending 30 metres north. Buses proceed from Brixton Road to stand.  
Set down in Brixton Road, at Stop P (233 - Brixton Station) and pick up in Brixton Hill, at Stop Y (29685 - Lambeth Town Hall).

AVAILABILITY:	Available from 00:01 until 16:00 only. Buses on Route 333 must not use this stand outside these times.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Brixton.
OTHER INFORMATION:	Available Mondays to Fridays before 1600 only and all day Saturdays and Sundays. At other times use Brixton, Lambeth Town Hall (Brixton Hill) stand.

**Brixton, Stockwell Park Walk (from Tooting Broadway)**

Public stand for ten buses on the north side of Stockwell Park Walk commencing 15 metres east of a point opposite Astoria Walk and extending 123 metres west.

Buses proceed from Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk to stand, departing via Stockwell Park Walk to Brixton Road.

Set down in Brixton Road, at Stop S (231 - Brixton Station) and pick up in Brixton Road, at Stop P (233 - Brixton Station).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Brixton.

**Kennington Church (from Tooting Broadway)**

Buses proceed from Clapham Road, Caldwell Street, Brixton Road, Camberwell New Road departing to Kennington Park Road.

Set down in Clapham Road, at Stop W (25642 - Albert Square) and pick up in Kennington Park Road, at Stop R (25648 - Oval Station).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	<b>Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand</b>
BLIND DISPLAY:	Kennington Church.

**Newington Butts (from Tooting Broadway)**

Buses proceed from Newington Butts, departing to Newington Butts.

Set down in Newington Butts, at Stop BL (2140 - Newington Butts) and pick up in Newington Butts, at Stop BD (2141 - Newington Butts).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	<b>Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand</b>
BLIND DISPLAY:	Newington Butts.

**Elephant & Castle, Borough Road, North Side**

Public stand for three buses on the north side of Borough Road, starting 104m east of the junction of Borough Road and Southwark Bridge Road and extending 38m east. Buses proceed from Newington Causeway, Gaunt Street, Southwark Bridge Road, Borough Road to stand, departing to Newington Causeway.

Set down in Newington Causeway, at Stop F (33624 - Elephant & Castle / Newington Causeway) and pick up in Newington Causeway, at Stop G (33625 - Elephant & Castle / Newington Causeway).

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 2 buses on Route 333 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
BLIND DISPLAY:	Elephant & Castle.
OTHER INFORMATION:	No toilet facilities available.

\* For this Route Agreement, clause 46 of Annex B of the Framework Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following clause:

**“46. INCENTIVE PROVISIONS**

**46.1** The provisions contained in this Route Agreement in relation to Performance Payments only and not the Contract Extension Criteria shall for the purposes of this clause 46 be referred to as the “Incentive Provisions”.

**46.2** The following Contract Extension Criteria provisions shall not apply to this Route Agreement:

46.3.1 clause 2 and clause 44.2; and

46.3.2 Schedule IX in its entirety.

All other provisions of the Route Agreement shall continue to apply provided that where any other part of the Route Agreement relates to or can reasonably be inferred as relating to clauses 46.3.1 or 46.3.2 or any part thereof, such parts shall apply mutatis mutandis.”

6. Spare Vehicles – Any spare vehicles required for the provision of the Services shall be provided from within the Operator's overall garage resources. 1

- Existing Vehicles – The Operator shall ensure that all vehicles entering service on this route undergo refurbishment to the April 2021 Refurbishment Specification prior to entering service.

8. Route Risk Assessment - The Corporation acknowledges receipt of the Route Risk Assessment pertaining to route 333.
9. Contract Price Adjustment – applied from Tranche 730 onwards:

Paragraph 9.2.2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

The percentage price adjustment (R) is a 12-month rolling average given by: -

$$R = W \times \frac{1}{12} \times \sum_{i=1 \dots n}^{n=12} \frac{P_{i+1} - P_{i+13}}{P_{i+13}}$$

Where:

- W = 0.85 representing the proportion of the Contract Price that is to be adjusted by movement in the Consumer Price Index.
- $P_{i+1}$  = The Consumer Prices Index published for the month that is i+1 month prior to the anniversary of the Date of Tender as set out in Table D7BT published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS).
- $P_{i+13}$  = The Consumer Prices Index published for the month that is i+13 months prior to the anniversary of the Date of Tender as set out in Table D7BT published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS).

For the avoidance of doubt 15% of the prevailing Contract Price is non- adjustable.
