Net to Gross Ratio Commentary:


The LMS is currently within a reasonable range for net to gross ratio. Whilst the technical CBS areas require a high level of plant and the ratio may fluctuate through the coming design stages, the current target should remain the same.

Recommendations:

The current net to gross ration of approx. 55% is a reasonable target.

Primary vs Secondary Commentary:


The graph opposite benchmarks the LMS brief against similar projects with regard to the overall provision of Primary and Secondary support lab space.

Buildings with a more biological focus tend to have a greater primary lab requirement, whereas biomedical facilities (as at LMS) tend to be more reliant on secondary support labs.

The current brief includes an approximate 40:60 primary to secondary lab ratio which is in line with the programmatic expectations of the Institute.

Recommendations:

the required provision for primary and secondary lab space can be benchmarked. Although, it is not expected to be drastically different from the current provision.
