

# THE CONTRACT DATE is the 23th day of February

2018

#### **BETWEEN**

- Tramtrack Croydon Limited T/a London Trams of Windsor House, 42-50
   Victoria Street, London SW1H 0TL (hereinafter called "the Employer") which expression shall include its successors in title and permitted assignees, and
- 2. Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure Ltd, a company incorporated in and in accordance with the laws of ENGLAND AND WALES having as its registered number and its registered office at (hereinafter called "the Contractor").

#### **RECITALS**

- (A) This Form of Agreement is made pursuant to a framework agreement between Transport for London and the *Contractor* dated 1<sup>st</sup> **April 2017** ("the Framework Agreement").
- (B) The *Employer* wishes to appoint the *Contractor* to carry out *works* being the renewal works of the London Trams (TfL) Blackhorse Lane Bridge South and London Borough of Croydon's (LBC) Blackhorse Lane Bridge North (Stage One) for which the *Employer* has submitted to the *Contractor* his Request Form.
- (C) The *Employer* has accepted a proposal by the *Contractor* for the design and construction of the *works* and correction of Defects therein in accordance with the *conditions of contract*.

### **OPERATIVE PROVISIONS**


 In this Form of Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, words and expressions shall have the same meaning as set out in the conditions of contract.

- 2. The *conditions of contract* are the NEC3 Engineering and Construction Contract (Third edition April 2013) together with and as amended by the main Option, dispute resolution Option, and secondary Option clauses as specified in the Contract Data Part One and Z (being the amendments set out in Schedule 2 of the Framework Agreement).
- 3. This contract shall mean this document and the following documents which are hereby incorporated into and shall comprise this contract
  - 3.1 the *conditions of contract* (including, for the avoidance of doubt, the Option Z clauses set out in Schedule 2 of the Framework Agreement),
  - 3.2 the Contract Data Part One,
  - 3.3 the Contract Data Part Two.
  - [3.4 the BIM Protocol Not Used
  - 3.5 the Works Information,
  - 3.6 the Site Information,
  - [3.7 the Pricing Information,
  - 3.8 Not Used
  - 3.9 the Contractor's quality statement.
- 4. The several documents forming this contract are to be taken as mutually explanatory of one another. In the event of any ambiguity they shall be construed in the order set out in Clause 3 of this Form of Agreement.
- 5. The Contractor Provides the Works in accordance with this contract.
- 6. The *Employer* pays the *Contractor* for complying with his obligations to provide the *works* the amount due in accordance with this contract.
- 7. This contract and the warranties and undertakings in it are deemed to apply to all work and/or services performed by the *Contractor* both before and after the Contract Date.
- 8. The Contractor warrants and undertakes to the Employer as a condition of this contract that he has all the resources including financial, technical and human resources as are required to carry out and complete his work in accordance with this contract. The Contractor shall neither be entitled to any additional payment nor excused from any obligation or liability under this contract due to any misinterpretation or misunderstanding by it of any fact relating to the works.

- 9. Notwithstanding the manner of execution of this contract it is agreed that:
  - 9.1 the limitation period within which any claim may be brought by the Employer for breach of this contract by the Contractor is 12 years from the date of breach; and
  - 9.2 the Contractor agrees not to raise in defence of any such claim a shorter limitation period whether pursuant to the Limitation Act 1980 (as the same may be amended or re-enacted from time to time) or otherwise.

This Form of Agreement has been executed as a deed and delivered on the date stated at the start of this Form of Agreement.
