

**National Buildings Database [prj 1821]: Additional Questions Batch 2**

**Question 1:** *The response that the price information should be included in the 24-page limit seems to contradict the ITT, which states on page 8: "The maximum page limit for tenders is 24 (excluding declarations, pricing schedule CVs, and risk register), using standard 2.54cm margins on each side, Arial font size 11."*

*Could you please confirm that the above text from page 8 of the ITT still stands?*

*The reason for asking is that the price information as set out in Annex A is mostly in 12 point text and runs to 4 pages before it is completed. When completed it could run to 5 or 6 pages and if included in the 24-page limit this would seriously detract from a proposer's ability to adequately describe the technical aspects of the project.*

**A:** The statement on Page 8 of the ITT is still accurate and the completed Annex A Pricing Schedule is not included in the page count. The response to a clarification question asking whether answers on price information (2.4) are excluded from the page limit (published 29/06/23) was interpreted as referring to any additional written response submitted in answer to price information (2.4) (that is any additional document submitted in addition to the completed Annex A Pricing Schedule). Any additional response submitted alongside the completed Annex A Pricing Schedule under price information (2.4) will be counted towards the page limit.
