Required Insurance

1. The Contractor shall, in accordance with Condition 23A, take out and maintain the insurances as set out in Table 1 (Required Insurance) below and in accordance with the insurance policy terms detailed in Annex A of this Schedule 22.

Annex A - Third Party Public and Products Liability Insurance

1.1 Insured

The Contractor.

1.2 Interest

To indemnify the insured (as set out in Condition 1.1 above) in respect of all sums which the insured (as set out in Condition 1.1 above) shall become legally liable to pay as damages, including claimant's costs and expenses, in respect of accidental:

- 1.2.1 death or bodily injury to or sickness, illness or disease contracted by any person;
- 1.2.2 loss of or damage to physical property;

happening during the period of insurance (as set out in Condition 1.4 below) and arising out of or in connection with the Contract.

1.3 Limit of Indemnity

Not less than [xxxx] (£xx,000,000) in respect of any one occurrence, the number of occurrences being unlimited, but any one occurrence and in the aggregate per annum in respect of products and pollution liability (to the extent covered by the policy). Where the limit of indemnity is provided in the annual aggregate, Condition 1.4 will apply.

1.4 Period of insurance

From the Effective Date of the Contract and for the duration of the Contract and renewable on an annual basis unless agreed otherwise.

1.5 Principal cover features and extensions

- 1.5.1 Indemnity to principals clause under which the Authority shall be indemnified in respect of claims made against the Authority in respect of death or bodily injury or third party property damage arising out of or in connection with the Contract and for which the Supplier is legally liable; and
- 1.5.2 Legal defence costs.

1.6 Maximum deductible

Not to exceed £[To be updated prior to Contract Award] for each and every third party property damage claim (personal injury claims to be paid in full).
